Overall, the students were satisfied with the course, especially in the light of the abrupt change from on campus teaching to distance teaching due to Covid-19. Still, students raised some points for further improvement in the next year. One aspect was that the responsibility for the whole course was laid on the shoulders of one person. Students had the impression that it could have been useful to add some assistance. Moreover, they would like to have more concrete examples of when the learned theories can be applied. Additionally, it was mentioned that some leactures were overloaded with information and the instructions for the excersise should have been more concise and in line with the course literature. Still, most students were very satisfied with the job of the teacher and are impreesed by the teacher's skills to cope so well with the given circumstances.
