























Course leaders comments

The response rate was 55%, which may be acceptable but not optimal.

The fact that everything was given online have created particular conditions for the teaching methods and students' experiences.

The overall evaluation was positive. However, specialized forestry concepts have to be better explained. The course structure, assignments and material on Canvas can also be improved.

The mixed course group (nationalities, background etc.) was appreciated. It made the seminars and assignments more interesting.

The distance learning worked reasonably well although students missed discussions and interaction that come easier in a classroom. Things to improve in distance learning: Don't switch groups too often; Try to start and encourage discussions, despite that it's online; Put effort on very well planned lectures.

We will also clarify more to the participants how the modules are combined. The course may also concentrate more on in depth on fewer key topics (while others may be removed from the course).

Student representatives comments

The overall impressions about the course was good. Some smaller changes needs to be looked upon and changed to the next course date. It seems that many of the students had a struggle with understanding the costing modules and parts of the Life cycle Assesment modulus

The different modulus in the course was good, but the coruse tries to cover to much in each subject. The course would gain upon focusing on lesser modulus and looking deeper into these.

Because of the distance learning, the discussion in the virtual classroom struggled. Which the students missed. But the teachers were good to try to keep this up along the course.

Since the background knowledge about the forestry varies alot between the students. Some of the students feels that they lack knowledge about forestry and forest science. Maybe some voluntary basic litterature could be suggested to these students. Introducing this into the classroom would take up alot of time, time that could be spended on the actual subject off the course. Maybe the course also could be clearer that some background knowledge is needed in forest science.
