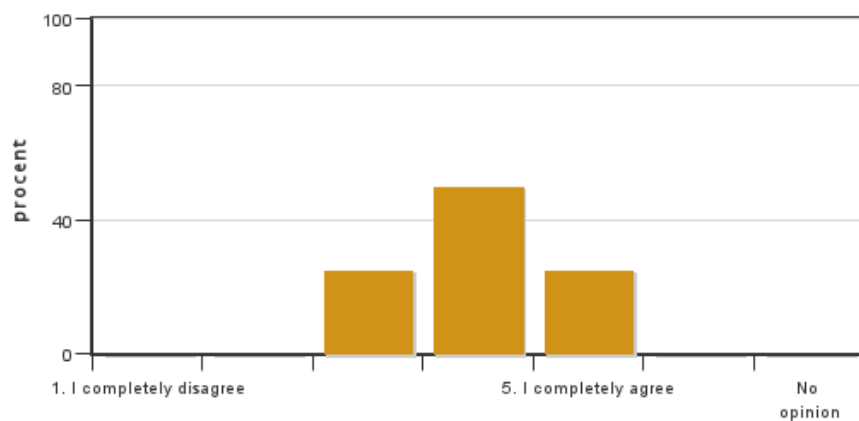

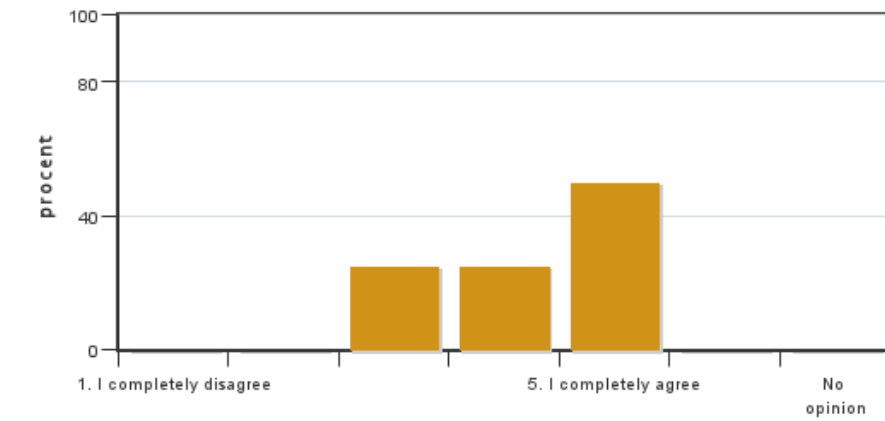

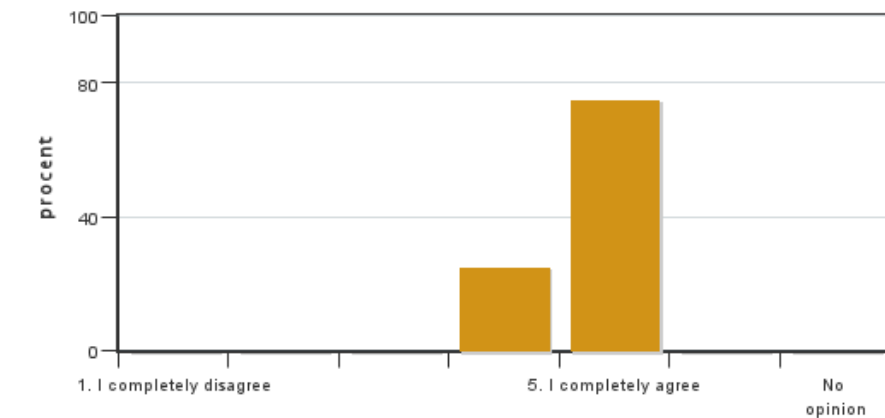

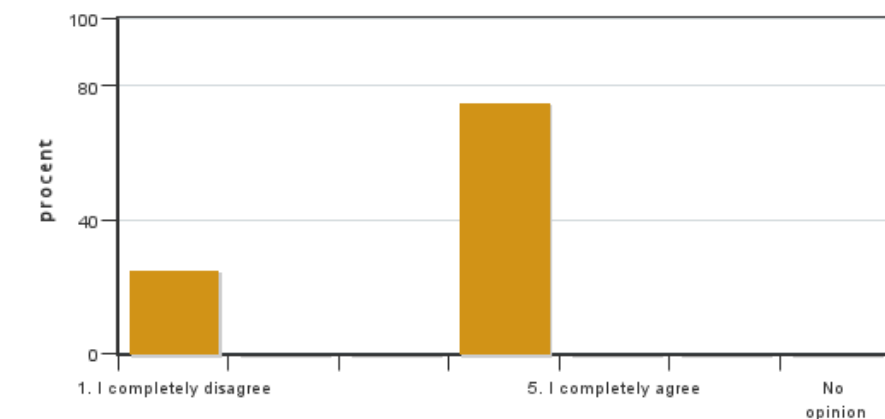

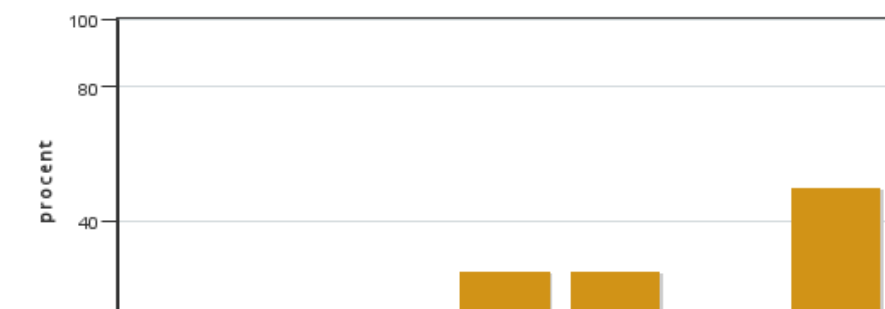

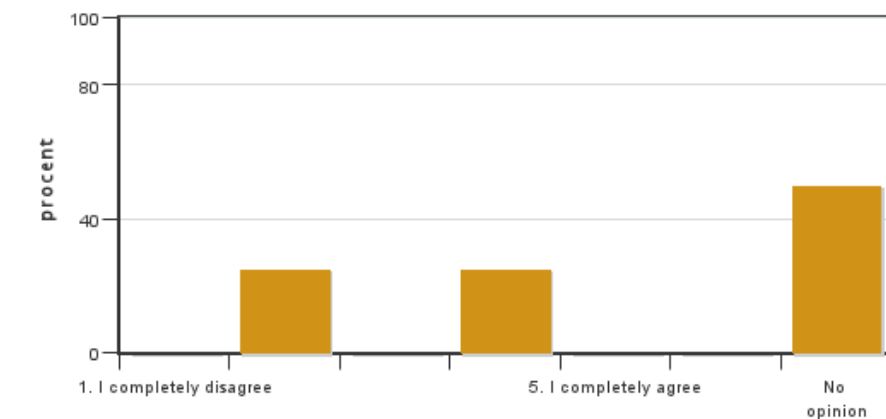

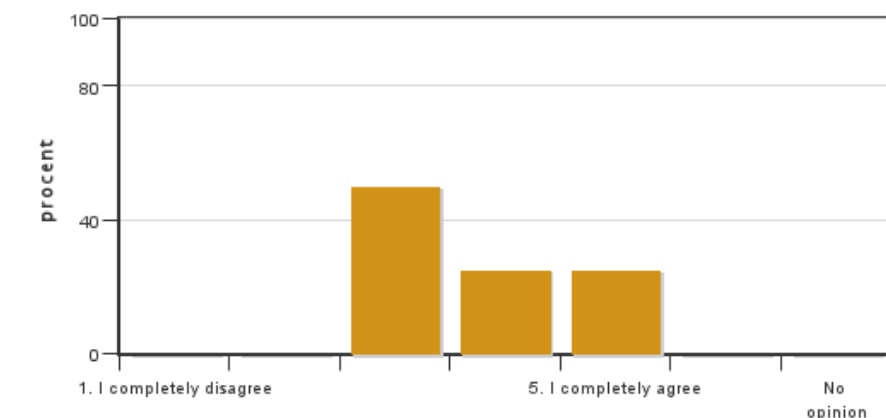

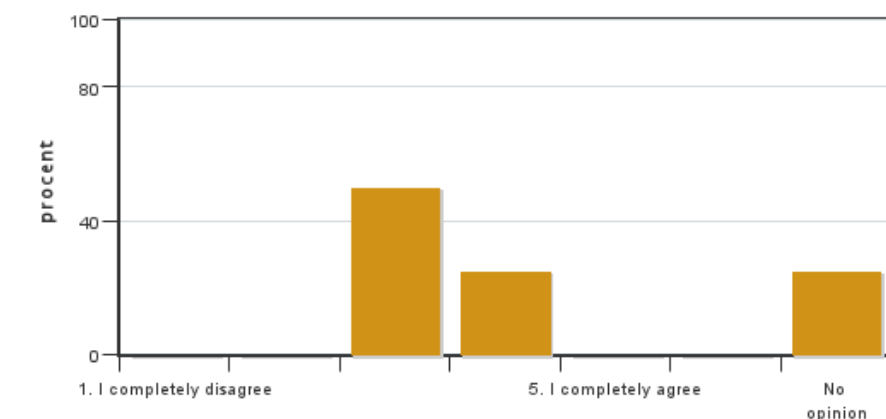

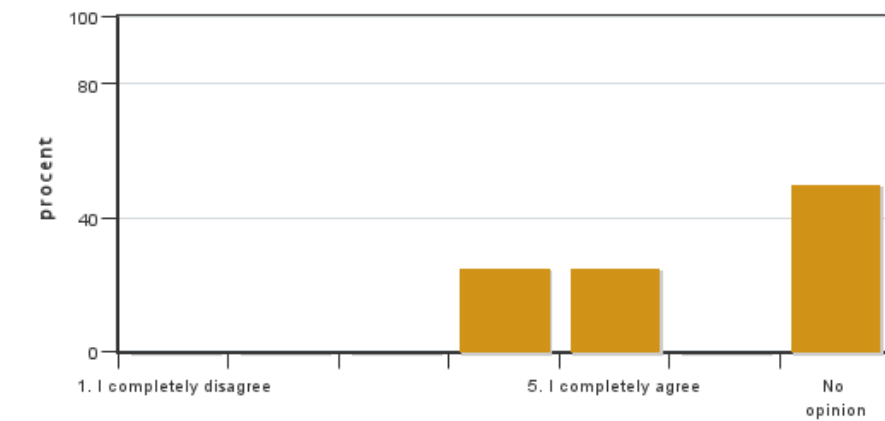

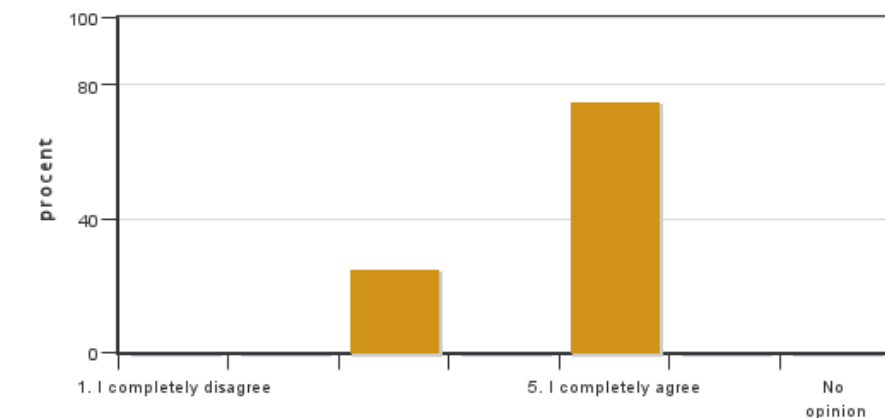

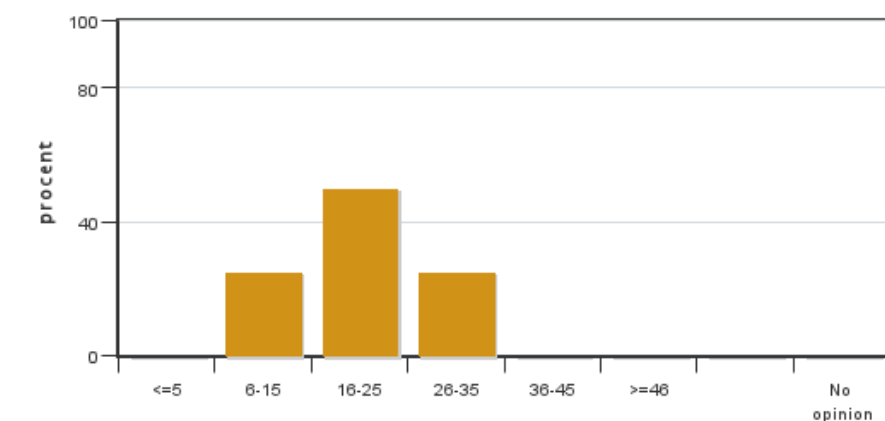

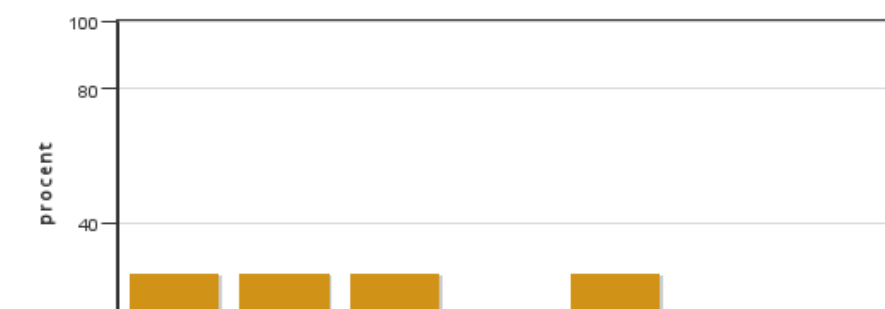

Student representatives comments

The overall impression of the course was that it was good and managed to convert into distance-studies in a good enough way due to all the material provided in the course. Most students thought that the course content was linked to the learning objectives in a good way and that they had good prior knowledge before the course.

The students missed oral lectures and discussions in the course. All lectures and oral discussions were canceled, which could have led to less learning due to that some students learn better and more via oral tools. Students missed the social environment. Considering the special conditions of Covid-19 the learning was perhaps sufficient, but not preferable.

The students also wish that the structure of the course will be clearer, perhaps in different parts/modules so that the material and learning objectives go together more easily.

The students felt pressured and stressed during the home exam due to lack of time.

The students request more extensive explaining of the essay before it starts.

The course covers sustainable development well.

Most students are not happy with the teaching on distance in the course, mostly due to the little presence of the teacher and lack of social environment provided. Although good comments were made about the teachers response-time on mail which was said to be good. Most students feel overall that they were not prepared for distance-teaching and that it was a big change for them.

If the course is to be a distance-course again the students would like online lectures, discussions of different topics that are monitored so that the students gain more understanding of the content with help from the teacher, weekly-zoom meetings for Q/A and more structured modules that are in direct contact with the objectives of the course so that the students can follow the course systematically by themselves.

Keep the study visits and the literature, both helped the students learning.

This course was given during an out-of-the-ordinary experience and therefore there are some suggestions for improvements in this course evaluation and some questions that are not usually in the evaluation have been added. I believe that Karin did her best with the time given to replan this course as a distance course, but if it is to happen again there is room for further improvement.
