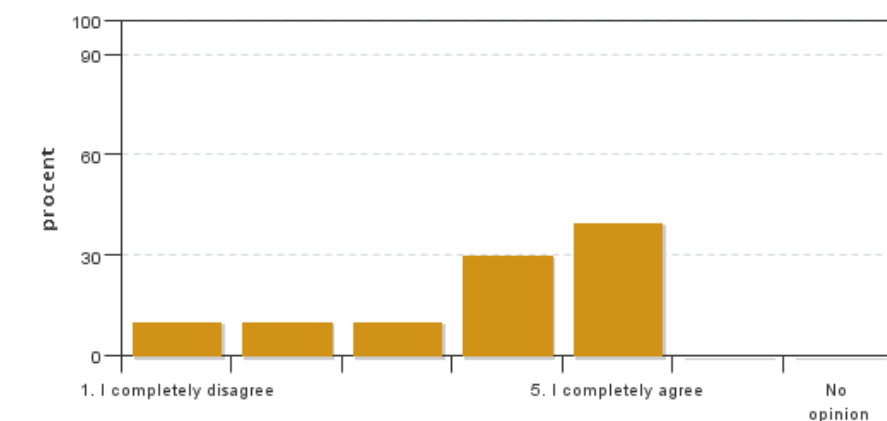

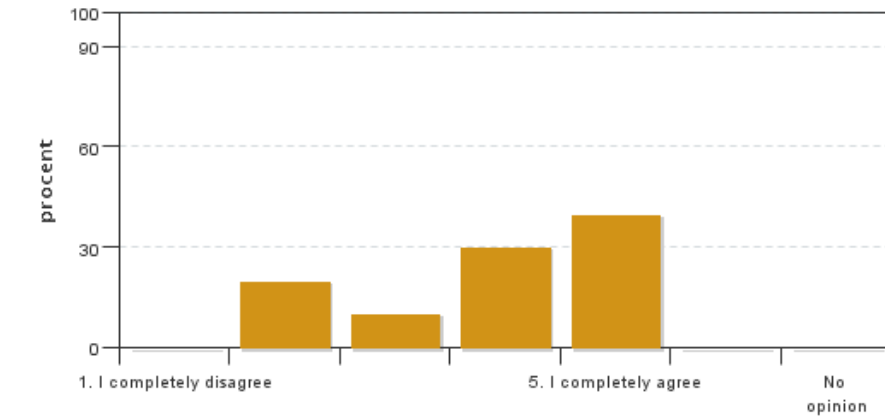

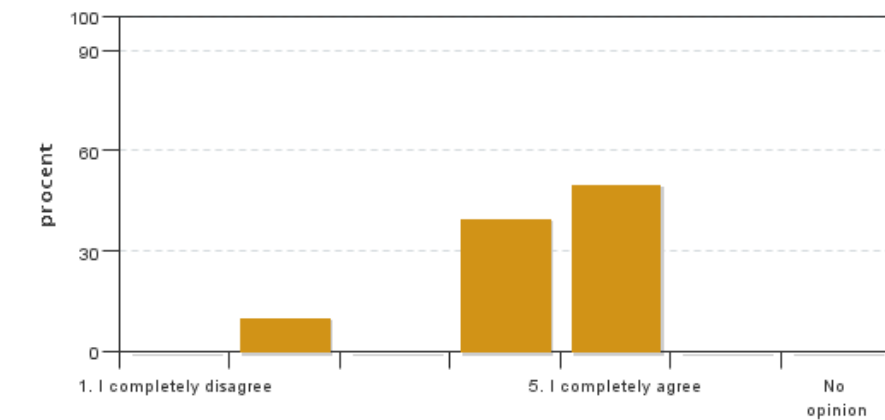

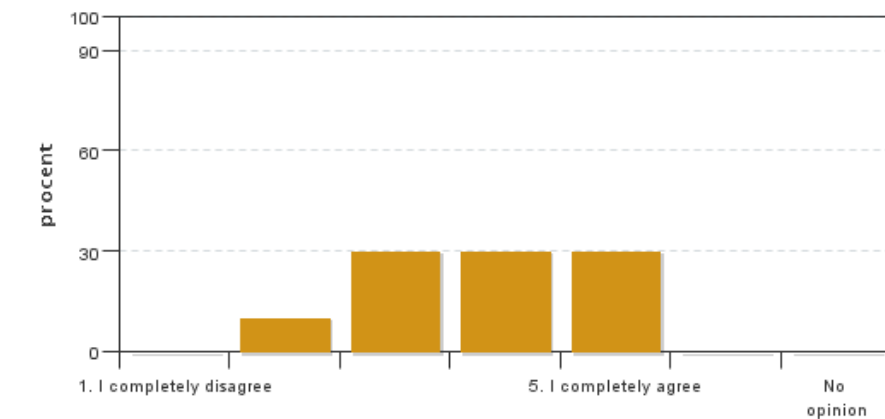

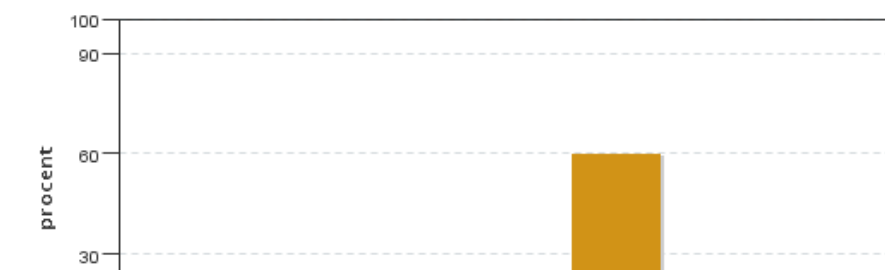

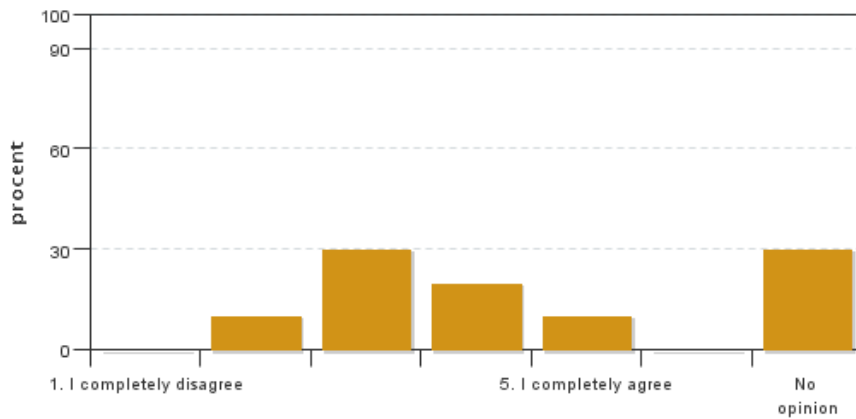

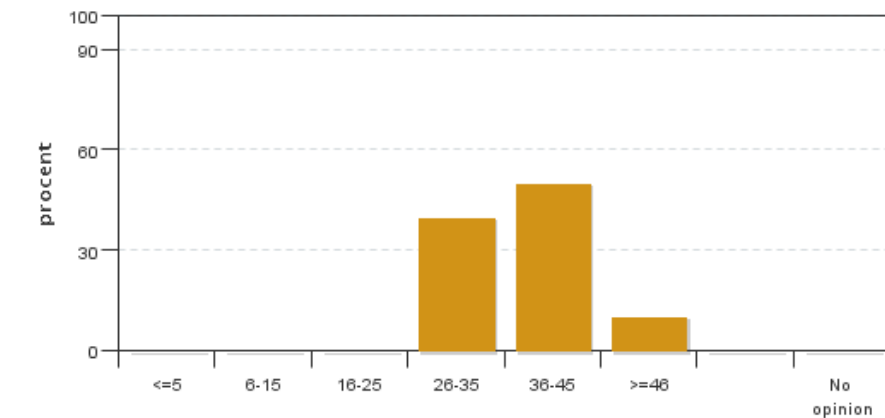

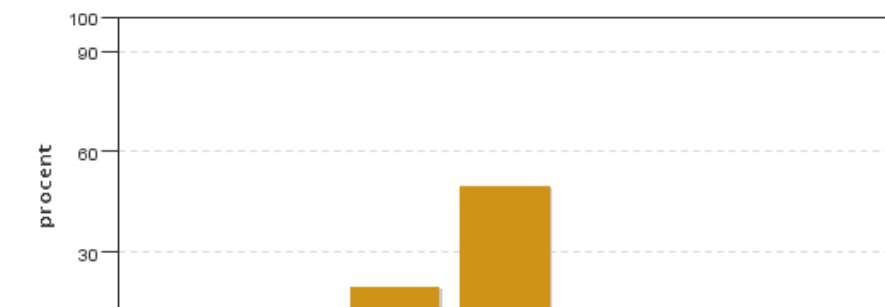

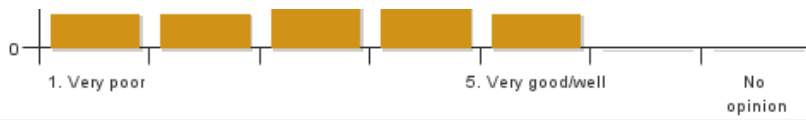

Course leaders comments

I discussed the course with the student representative. Overall, we thought several things went well with the course, and many students enjoyed the course, including the content, the PBLs, many of the Lectures, and the computer simulations. We discussed challenges of running the course during the pandemic, and the difficulty of Zoom as a format. Aside from that, we discussed that the students would appreciate more connection expressed to them between the different elements. We talked about breaking the course into 3 separate modules next year. We also discussed the need to distinguish for the students the really important core foundational lectures versus PhD and/or Post lecture that focus on more applied topics, to help student prepare for the exam. We also discussed that the final written exam should be less difficult, and students should be given more time. The oral exam format was a big success, and we agreed we should stick with that format next year.

Student representatives comments

"This year has been a special year for us all that has been embossed by distance learning. This has led to temporary solutions that sometimes has been good and sometimes less good. But this can be good to keep in mind that the teachers aren't used to teaching at a distance. This year it was a lack of participant in the evaluation of the course. The overall score was good but there are parts with potential for improvement. For example, the written exam was according to the students to niched and hard for the given time. But on the other side was the oral exam well laid out. Some student thought that some element of the course was too broad and didn't focus on what the student should be learning, after discussion with the course leader this was the plan and was this was to prepare the students for higher studies."
