





















Course leaders comments

The course was given as distance course due to the Covid pandemic situation. This was not optimal regarding measuring techniques, interaction between student-student and student-teacher, and excursions. But all teachers have done their best to compensate and find new digital solutions.

The fact that the students had very different knowledge background has been a consern in some comments. As a course leader I have instead seen the positive aspects of this diversity. The students have different views and background which make a good discussion climate and everybody have to question their own views.

All teachers look forward to give the course without pandimic restrictions, but use the experiences and continue develop the digital tools.

Student representatives comments

9 out of 20 students participated in the course evaluation. A majority expressed a good/very good overall impression of the course. Only two students reported a poor impression.

Due to the current circumstances caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, the entire course was on distance. All the practical elements (excursions and measurement methods exercises) had to be compromised to a digital experience and therefore we all felt that we missed out on important parts. This was of course unfortunate but nothing we could control. Nevertheless, the distance teaching worked well thanks to good organization, communication, and great enthusiasm from the course leader.

Regarding previous knowledge required for the course, some students reported that they had insufficient knowledge to fully follow the course.

A majority of the students felt that the examinations provided the opportunity to demonstrate what we had learned during the course. One student suggested that a final written exam would have been better suited, instead of a major project presentation.

From what was expressed at the mid-term evaluation and final course evaluation occasion, the major project assignment was highly appreciated. The clear framework of the project was really helpful.
