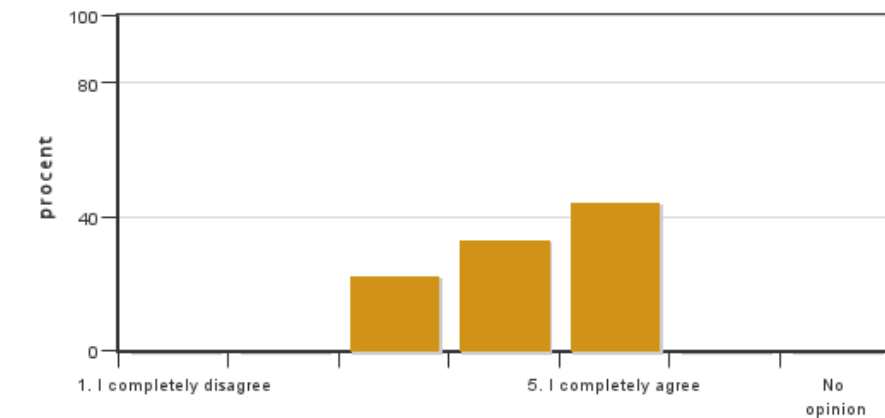

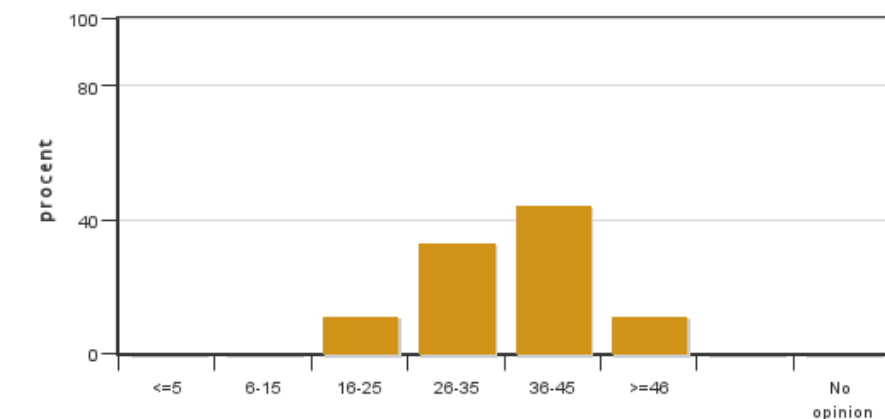

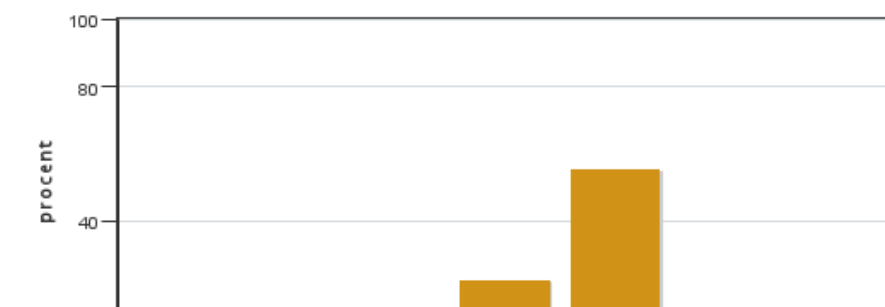

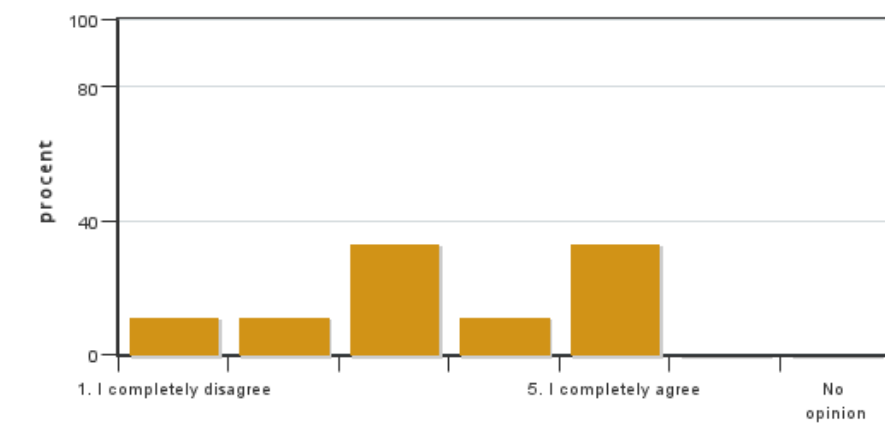

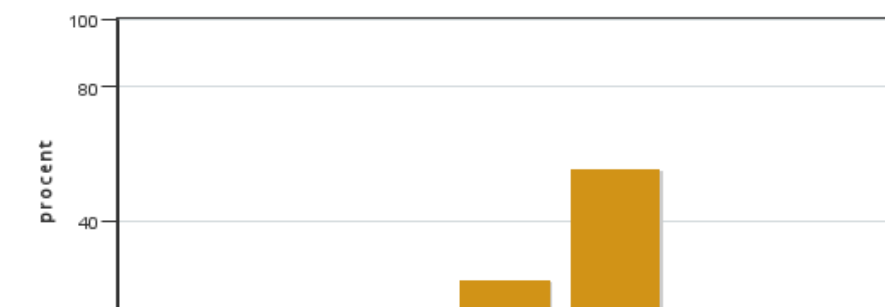

Course leaders comments

The overall evaluation of the course was good (4,4). Links to the learning objectives were acceptable (4,0) and the course information was easily accessible (4,7). The students perceived that the various course components supported their learning (4,3) and the social learning was good (4,6) as well as the physical learning environment (4,8). The examinations provided a good opportunity to demonstrate learnings (4,9) and students perceived the course to cover sustainable development aspects (4,9), international perspectives (4,2) and gender perspectives (4,4). The Covid-situation has had a major impact on the course and included educational activities. Still the students identify both positive and negative aspects connected to an on-line course. Positive aspects will be incorporated and considered post-corona.

The new course book seems to be more appreciated, compared to the one that was used previously. However, the link between the course book and teaching activities has to be developed further. Students also raised the idea to use a few horticultural cases, to analyse from different theoretical perspectives, during the course.

The exercise "the mini-review" was difficult, yet most appreciated (4,8) and this will thus be kept for next year. Additional exercises were also perceived as relevant, however small adjustments will be conducted. The student lectures were appreciated (3,9) and gave a good opportunity for practicing presentation technique, even though it could seem difficult and a bit scary beforehand. Adjustments will be considered.

Next year we will continue to further develop the inter-disciplinary parts of the course.

Within the teacher team we will also continue to work on developing the instructions connected to included exercises. We will also review the placement of certain elements to further create an even more logical sequence of certain parts. Finally international perspectives will be more highlighted.
