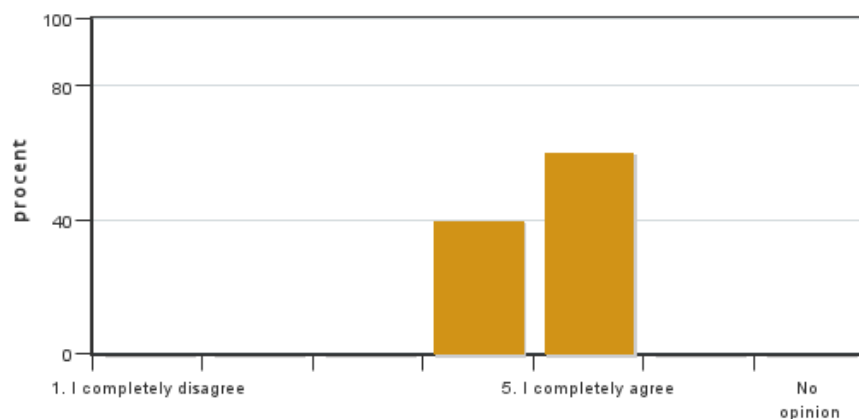

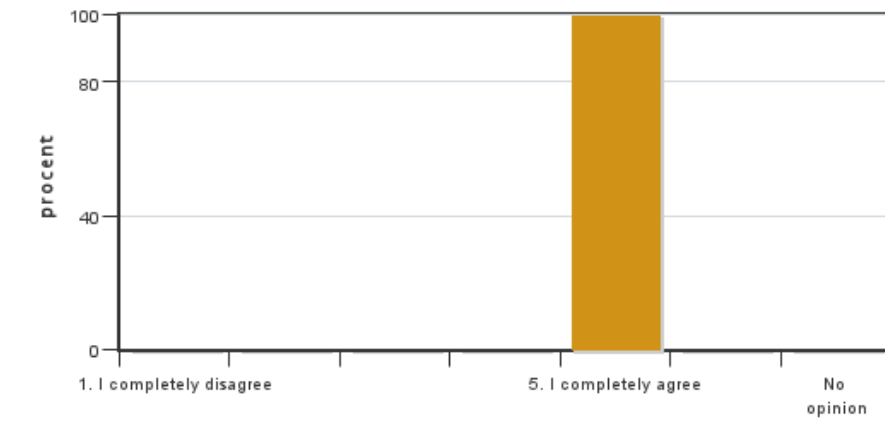

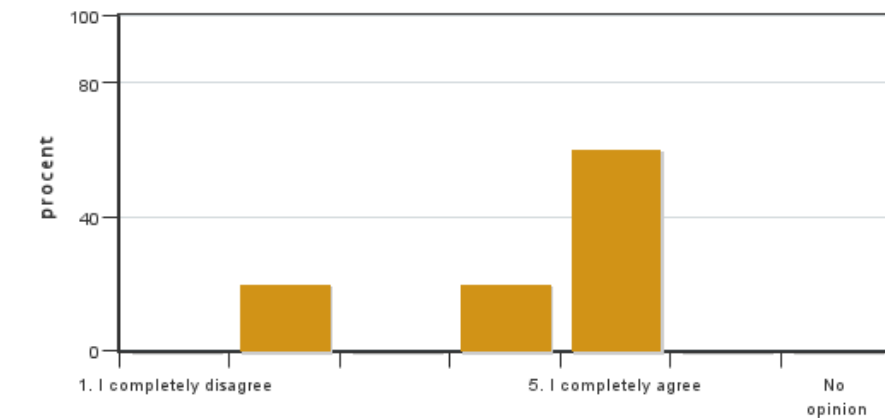

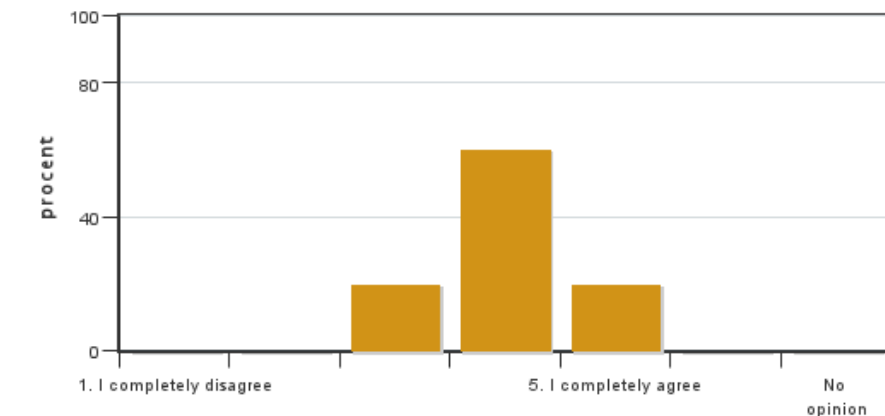

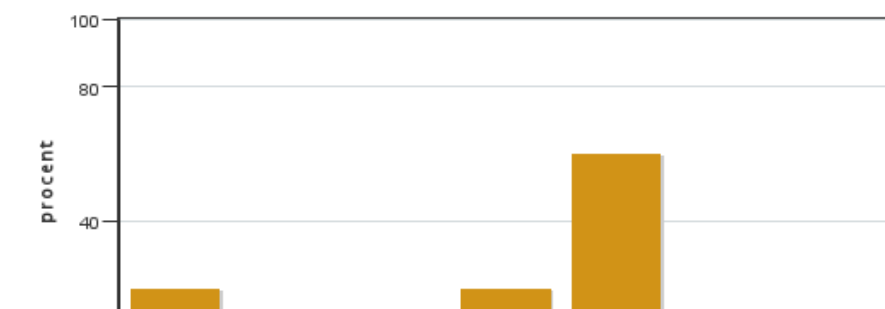

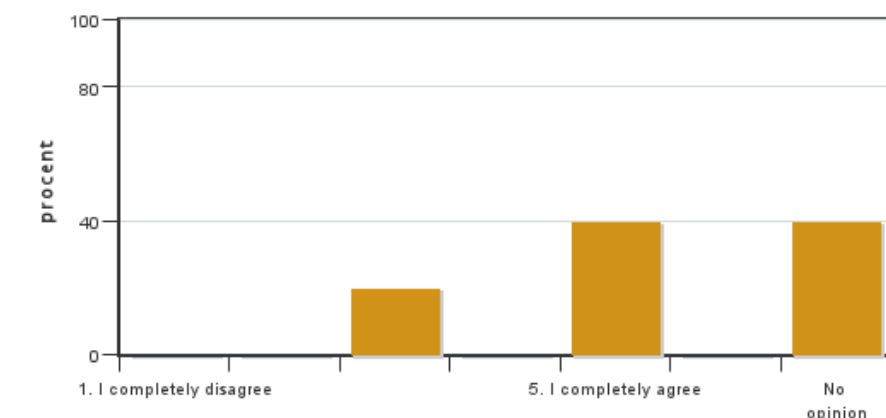

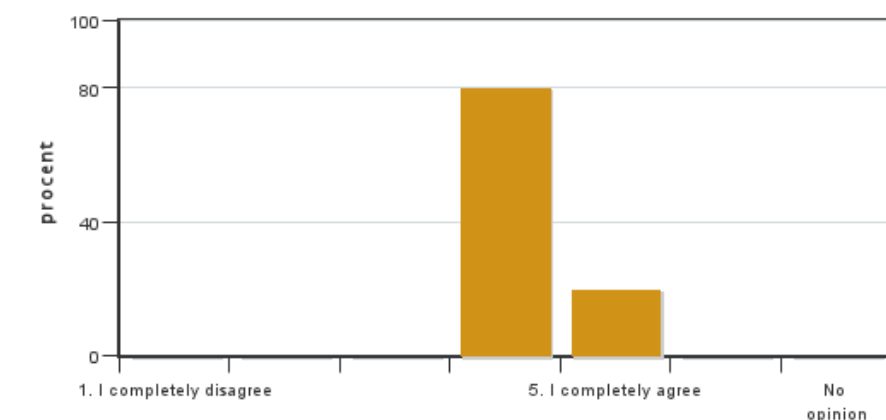

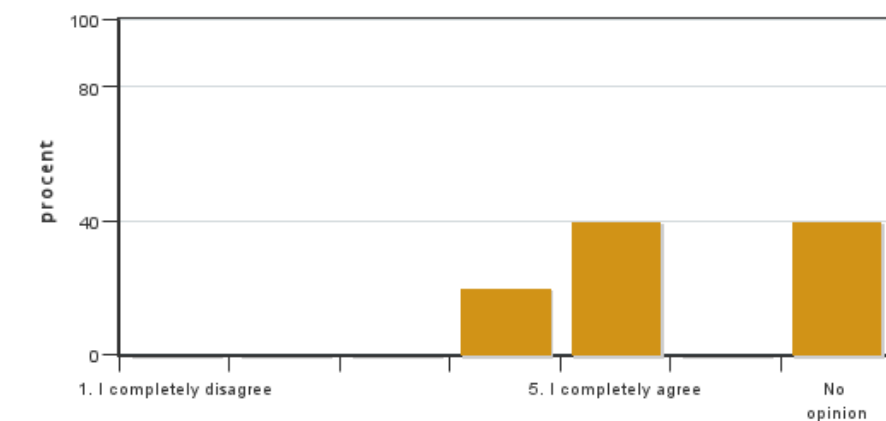

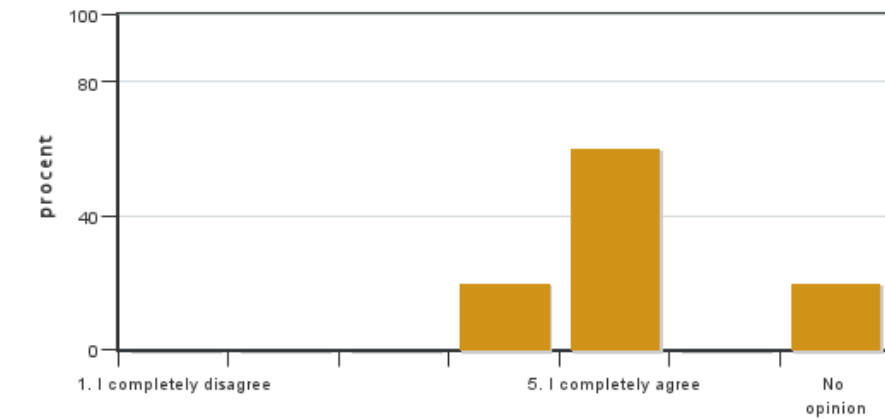

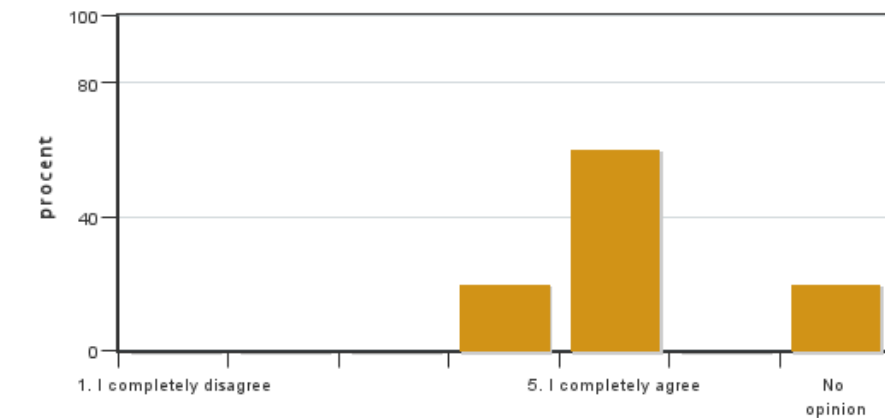

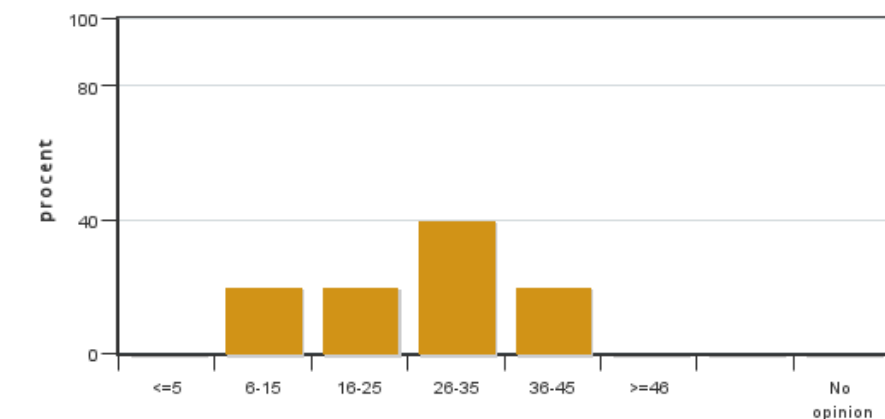

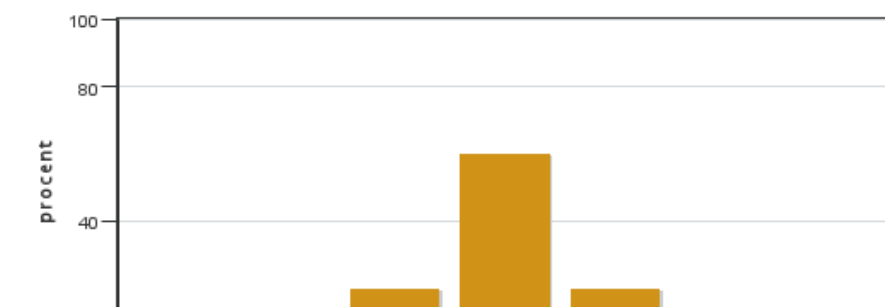

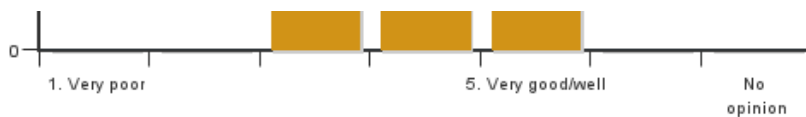

The suggestion of having the lectures recorded has been discussed, however, the majority of the speakers are not allowing this- due to immaterial rights of the speaker. However, this discussion will probably continue.

Some of the practical sessions were cancelled, and the course examiner has arranged with extra insurances so that it will be possible for this year's students to participate in the practical sessions of next year's course- if wanted. As for the suggestion of having cases to discuss, this will be implemented in the next years course- thank you!"

It would have been useful with shorter cases to discuss together, maybe once a week, to get a deeper understanding of application of the different assessment and treatment methods in different situations in different animals.
