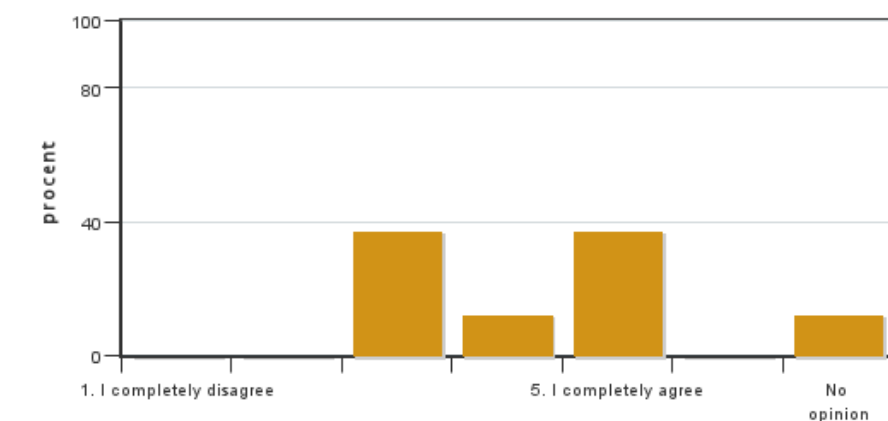

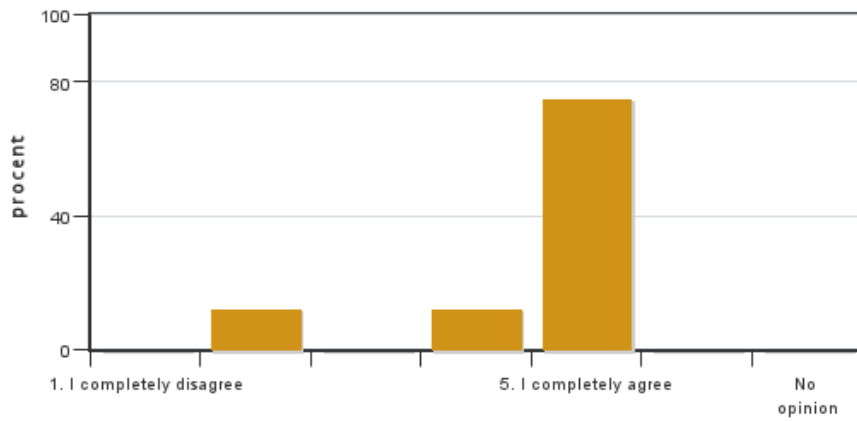

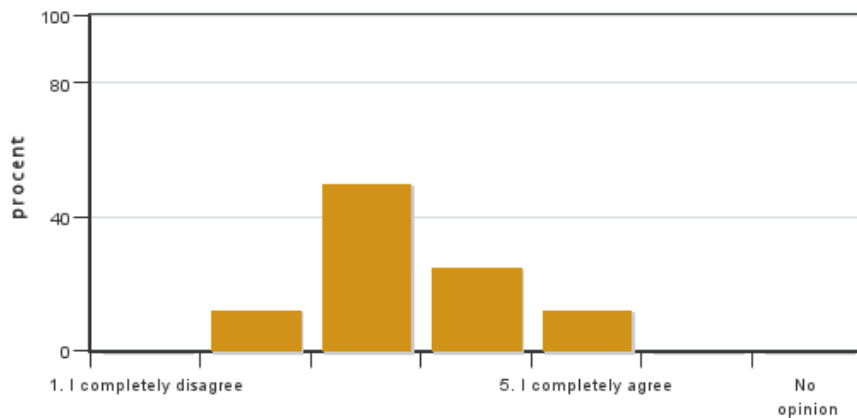

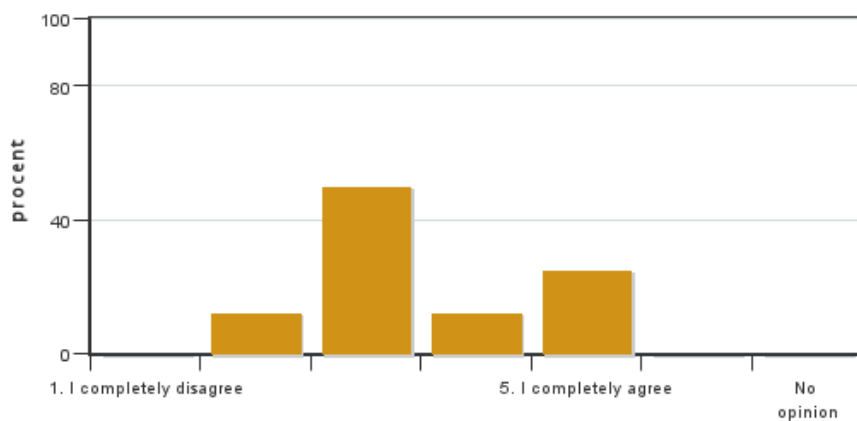

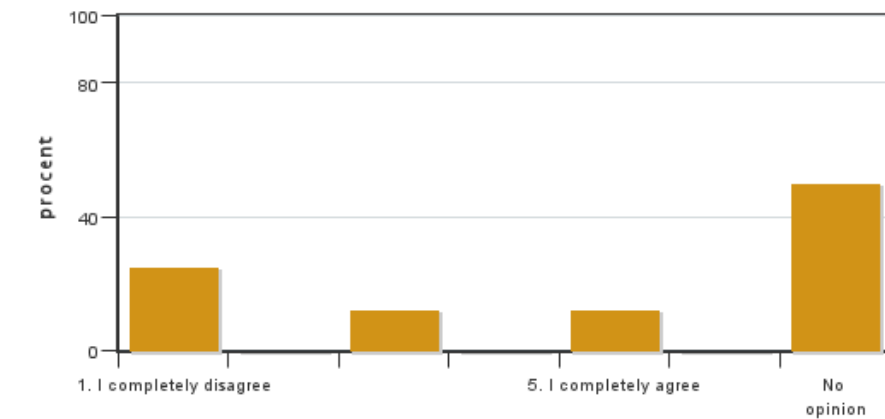

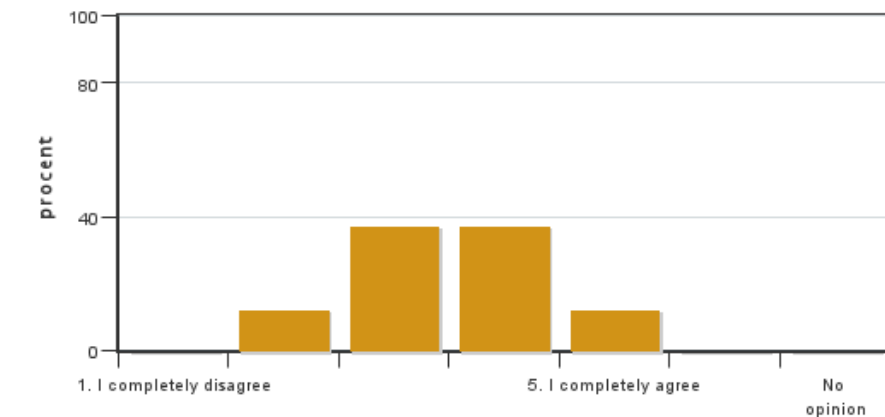

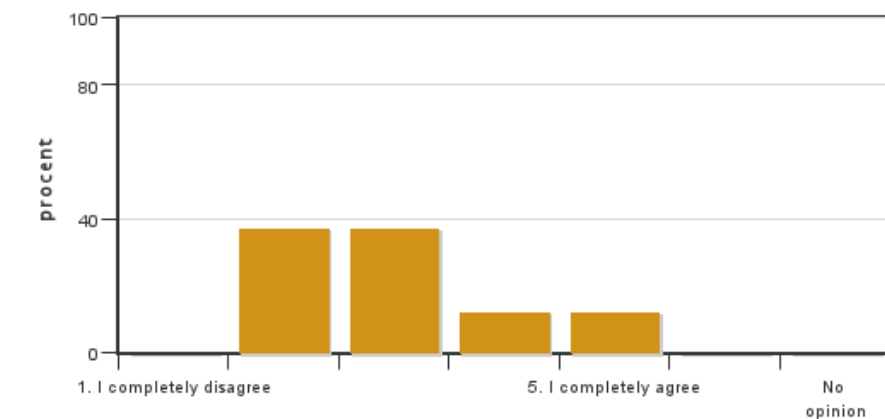

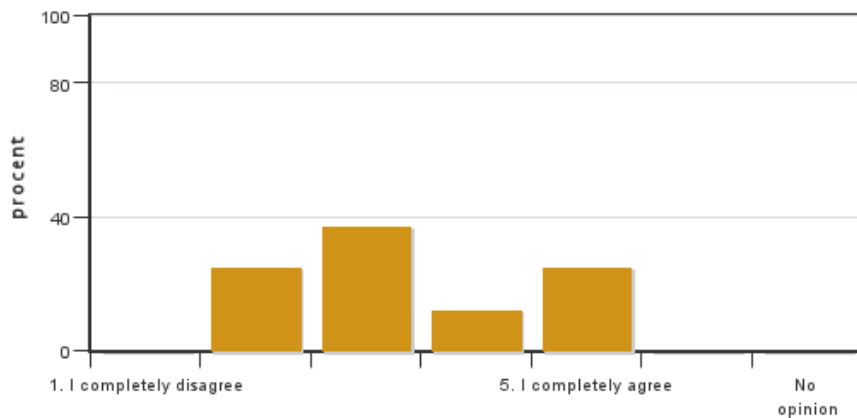

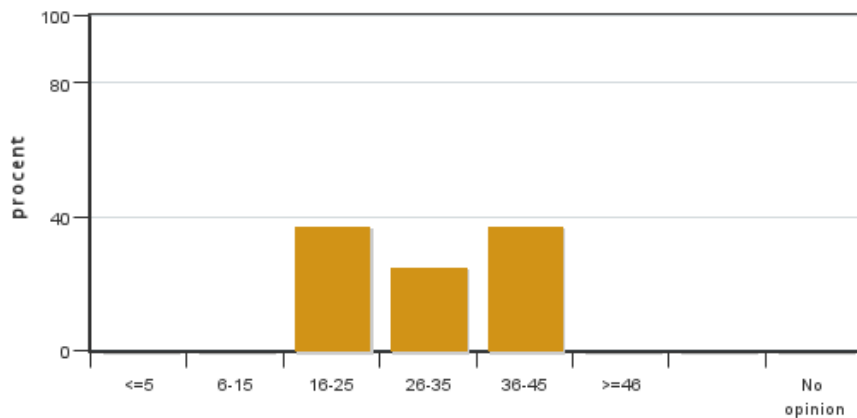

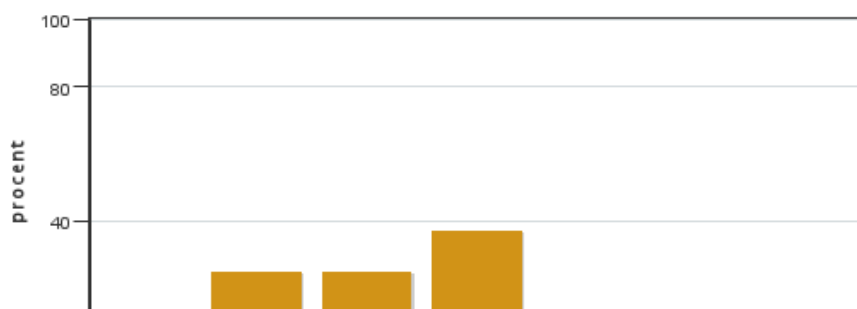

The course language in the labs was a limitation for our course as the course was officially offered in English however because many resources for practical parts are only available in Swedish, the non-Swedish students encountered difficulties. From next year, the course will be offered in Swedish as the official language.
