

















## Student representatives comments

The lecturer has treated all students equally in a satisfying way and has been present in the learning of the students, on request the course leader provided a very helpful go-through of an old exam in the end of the course, which helped bring all material together.

The whole course was given through online teaching because of the current spread of covid-19 and the adaption to this worked well with zoom rooms and recorded parts of lectures. As an unfortunate consequence of covid-19 the course leader was absent for a short period of time, which made the second part a little confusing and more difficult to grasp, where material was given out from another similar course.

The material for the course seemed quite big and the topic is not very easily grasped at first, but in my opinion the lecturer provided good explanations and lectures that made it more comprehensible and in the end the knowledge did come together as a fuller picture of what we had been studying. That said, the material is quite difficult to understand and demands time calculating and discussing the various models.

The group work in this course was interesting, as it is coded in R which is fun to work with, but quite difficult to manage when we had to do this online. Preferably, the group can share one computer and do the code together which is probably the normal case, instead of trying to manage the same code on two different computers, via telephone calls. Yet again, a consequence of the current pandemic.

My general opinion about this course is that it is interesting, well administered, quite difficult, time demanding and necessary for future higher studies!
