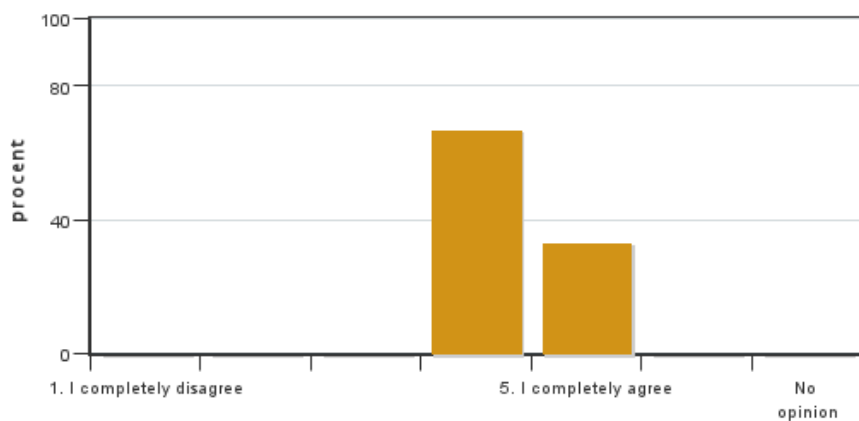

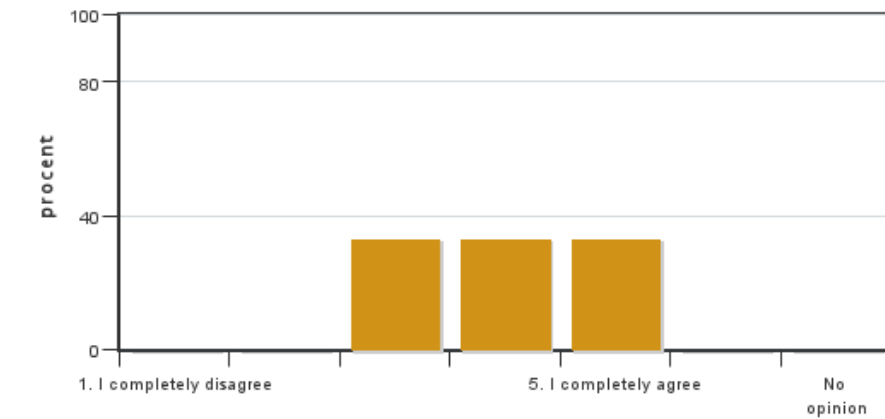

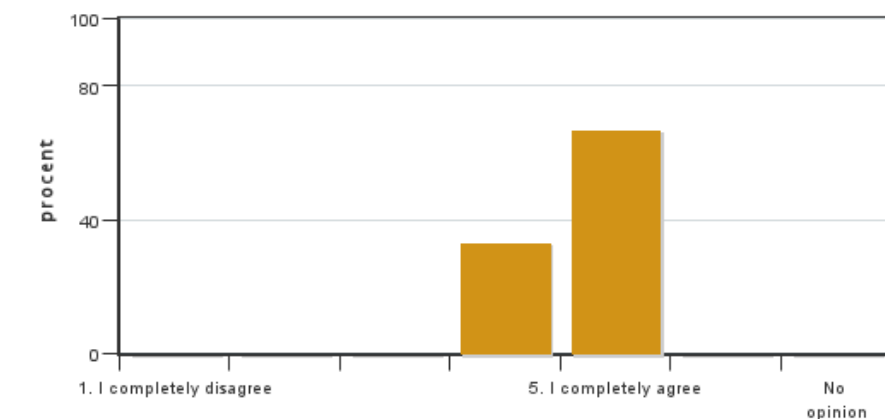

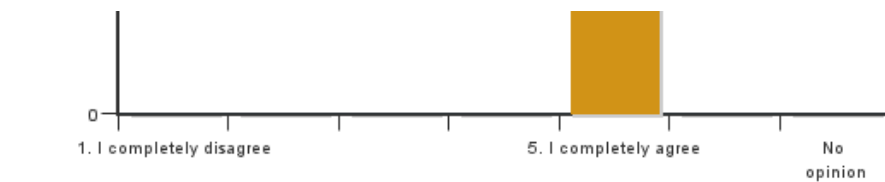

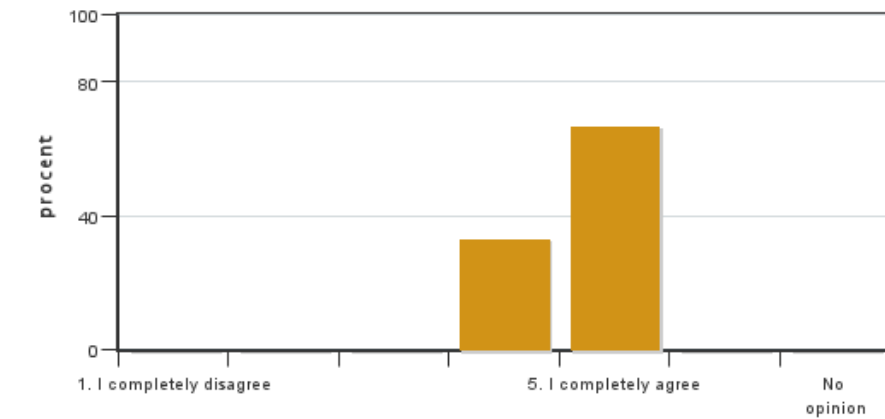

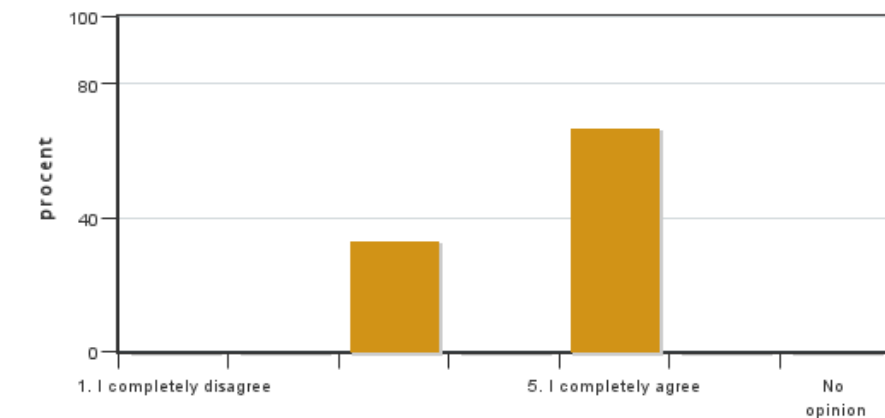

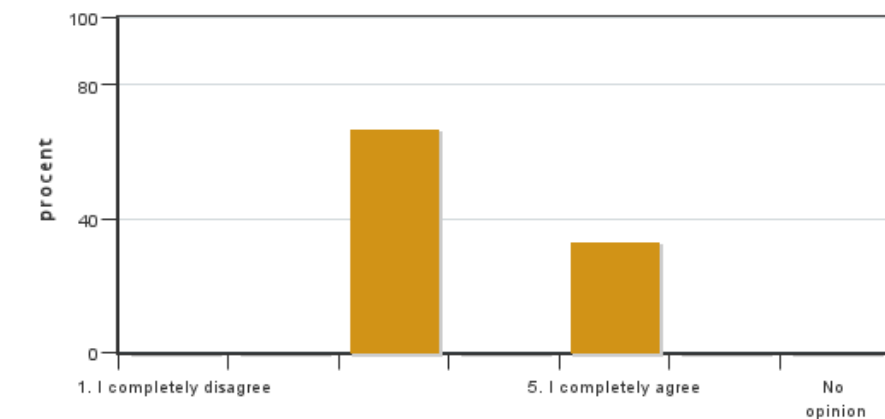

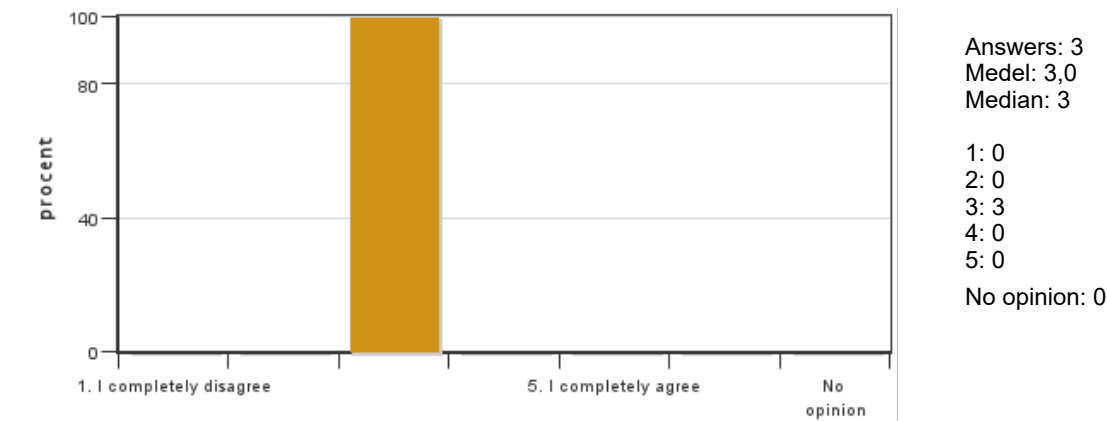
9. I received constructive feedback on the oral presentation of my project



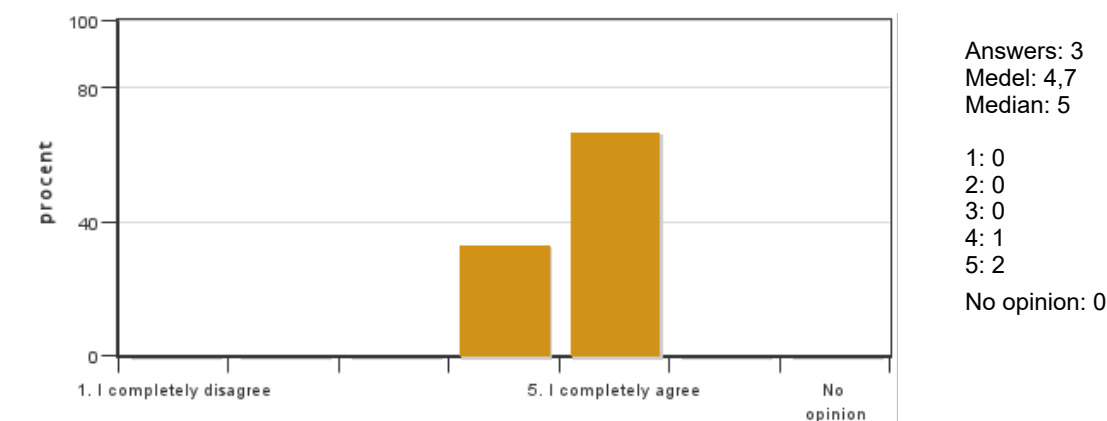

Course leaders comments

Thank you so much, students of EX0295, for being an active part of the course from start to the end – and for answering the course evaluation form. MUCH appreciated! You all provide grounds for a continuous improvement process that all courses and programs need.

As a course leader this course was a “dream course” in many ways (except for the budget, of course) – a very small class (3 students, all with ambitions to participate actively and help each other along in the respective project) and two thesis supervisors with a lot of experience. All of us were part of the post-Covid transition that means we get back to meeting each other in face-to-face dialogues. All of these dialogues (four seminars throughout the duration of the course) proved very valuable.

The course evaluation statistics reflects an overall satisfaction with the thesis process. Improvements can be made when it comes to administration – and the Canvas structure. A suggestion was also made for making Teams available for students to do interviews when collecting data (a quest from their respondents).

All of the thesis projects had a very clear connection to sustainable development so the high grade in that question does not come as a surprise (5). The three questions about feedback points to needs to clarify the role of thesis advisors and fellow students in the process (8, 9, 10). As for feedback on the oral presentations (9), all students received notes and feedback from the oral presentation of the final seminar, by the course leader, along with format comments (individual as well as collective).

An open-ended question (12) at the end of the evaluation offers constructive suggestions for improvements of the format for the Thesis Day that I will share with the persons responsible for that day. One of the suggestions is of particular interest; it asks for inviting non SLU-students to the thesis seminars to make the topic of their thesis, our educational programs and SLU as a whole more well known. I see this as a very good suggestion for diverse student recruitment efforts at SLU.
