

















Course leaders comments

1. The response rate is low, measures should be taken to increase the response rate for next year.
2. The number of hours spent by students seem to be low for some students.
3. The respondents seem generally to be satisfied with the course, the content, structure, connection with learning outcomes and examination.
4. The learning facilities got low scores. This is probably related to a dissatisfactory rescheduling of Campus based teaching to online teaching during a new period of Covid 19-related descriptions.
5. The literature should be updated and clearer reading instructions for the literature seminars should be given in advance.
6. The differences between seminars and workshops should be clarified in the schedule.

Student representatives comments

The standard SLU evaluation did not provide a lot of options to evaluate this course properly. It would be nice if there are options specified on quality of teaching as well as the quality of guest lecturers. Having said that, the guest lecturers were brilliant during this course and gave us both a better understanding of the topics they presented as well as putting them into the practical context. In doing so the guest lecturers were an important part of the learning outcome.

The scientific and book articles we had to read could be increased in number and chosen on higher quality. Additional learning material would be appreciated too.

The seminars could be prepared better, both clearer instructions for the students and better management from teachers during the seminars to maximize the learning.
