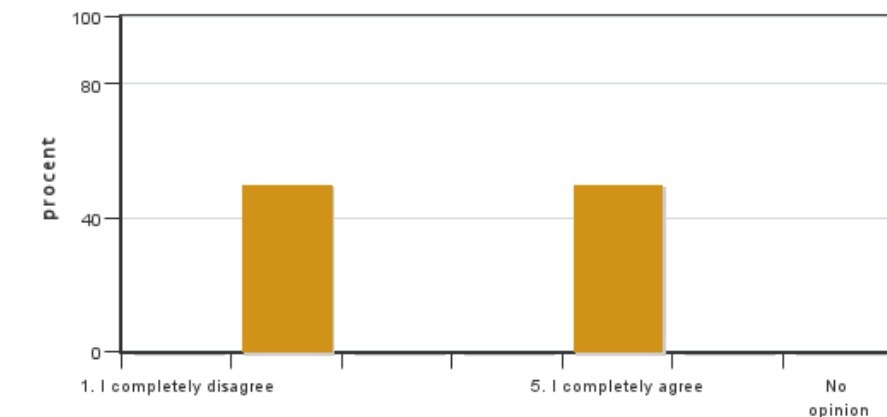

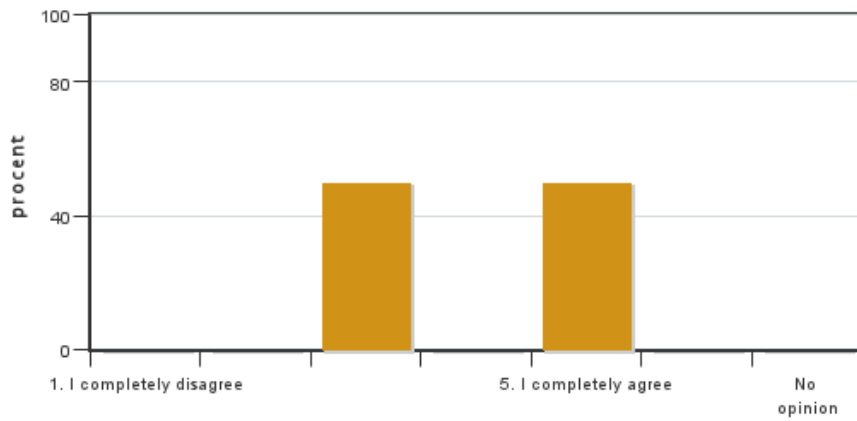

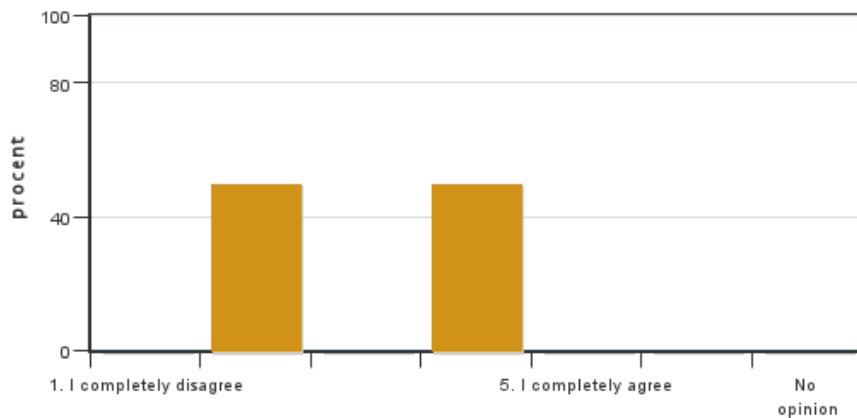

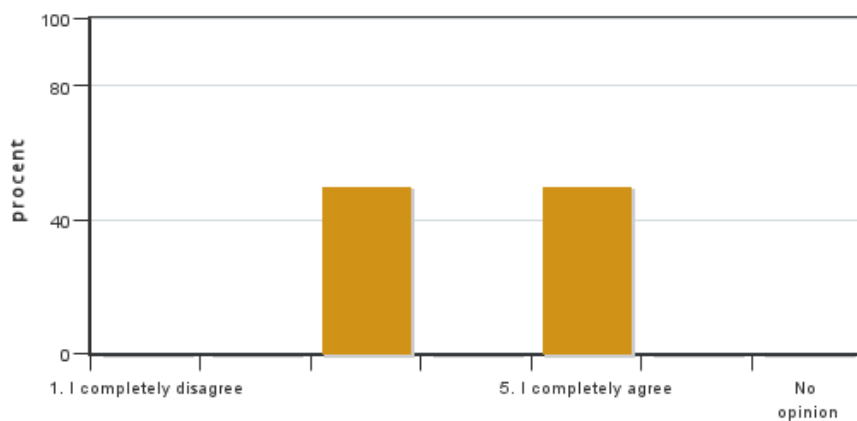

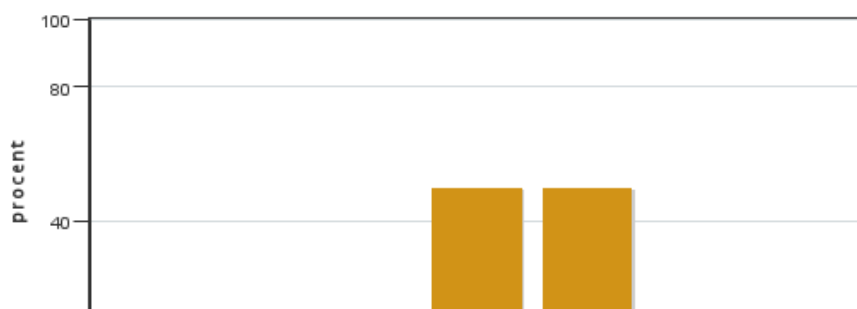

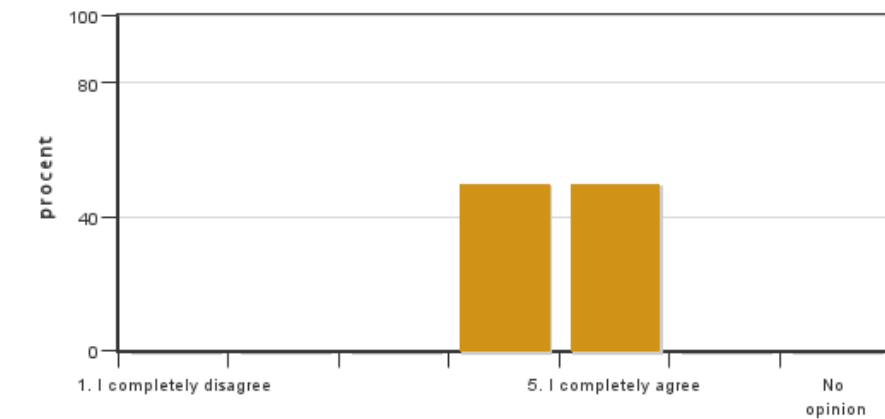

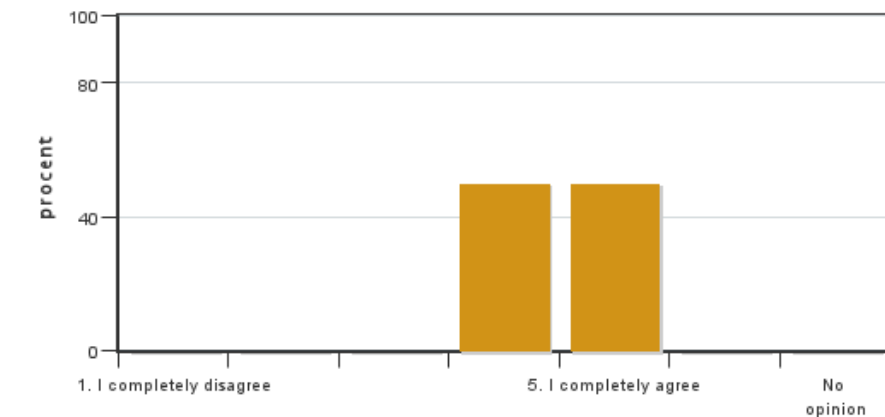

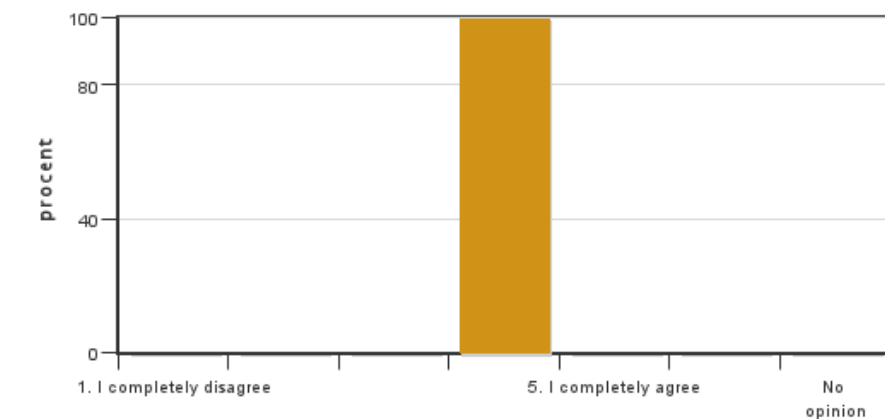

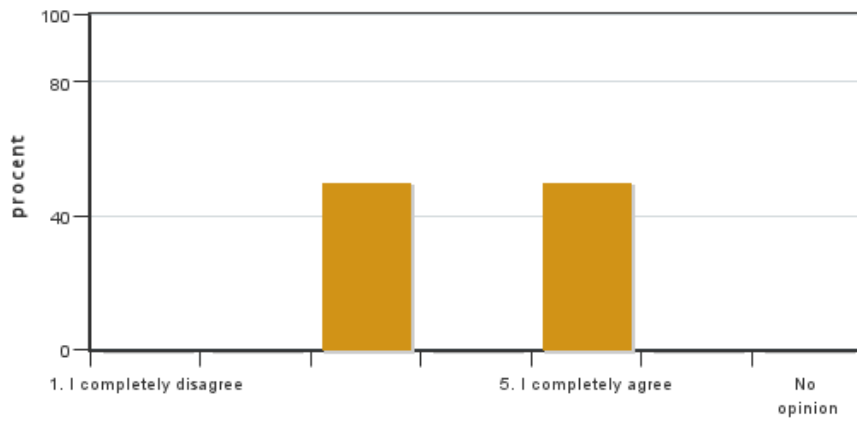

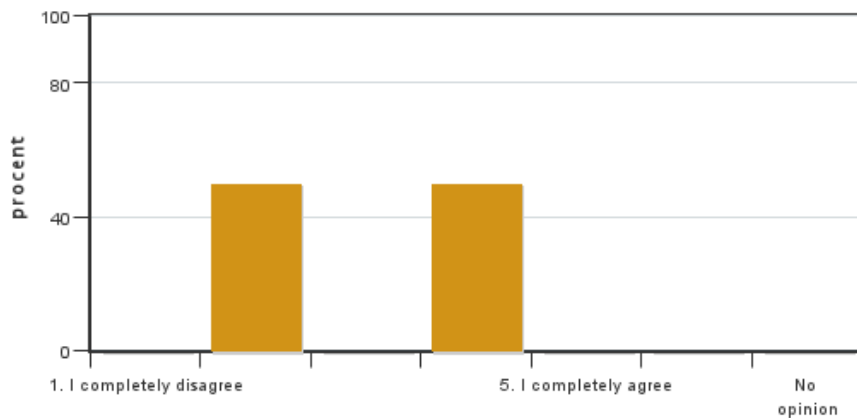

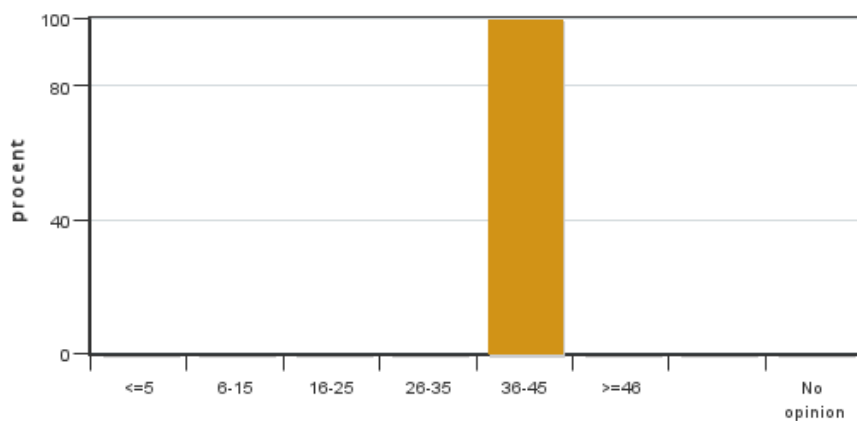

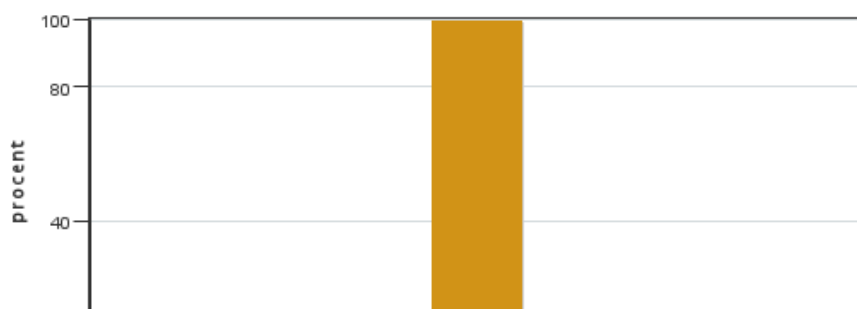

Even though the course got, on average, a grade of 4.5 over 5, it can't be ignored that the grading is based on the opinion of only 2 students out of 12. I did address the importance of the course evaluation as a tool of improving the course in all its aspects day 1, by the middle of the course, and again at the last week, on the occasion of the oral evaluation of the course. It is evident, than more work is needed to highlight this issue.

Nonetheless, based on the 2021 course evaluation some improvements have been made with regard of how files e information were organized in Canvas, as well as to assure that all the information provided in lectures, handouts, and course literature, even the additional one, was available in English.

Among other minors adjustments, for the coming year we plan to increase the time allocated to mathematical calculations and exercises, and to put more emphases on the "internationalization" of the contents.
