

















All in all, this year's course went well. It was good to have most lectures/seminars live compared to last year when we had to have the whole course in zoom. However, the last examination due to the Covid-pandemic had to be in zoom unfortunately. Some students claim that the lectures were repetition from earlier courses, this is expected as the course covers a wide area and the students have different background. Some students complain about compulsory lectures/seminars, we have compulsory lectures/seminars to create a good discussion climate and to have in depth discussion about research methods this cannot be accomplished in any other way than in the classroom.

One student claims that the information of the course was not enough and that information came too late. We always have thorough information about the course parts at the start of the course. However, all students did not attend the first days of the course and might therefore have missed important information. We could also see that some course participants did not understand the project work in the course, although we at several occasions have informed them about the course module. In addition, we had individual meetings with all students to make sure they understand the purpose of the project work. Usually, most students understand what they need to accomplish and this is the first time we have experienced that some students did not understand this part of the course. The reason for this is unclear. Maybe it depends on insufficient pre-knowledge in the subject area or lack of interest in accomplishing the course.
