Course leaders comments

The course provides several learning activities, where the hands-on workshops (Ligthscape and Soundscape labs) seems to be a good starter in the course getting people together. The timing of activities are in some cases questioned, eg the Case Place study, or to be more precise, the need to have the template for it earlier.

The study trip to Stockholm was highly appreciated, though support from the university would facilitate for the students to join. Unfortunately, this is not be possible, why it is important that the course responsible informs very early about it, then planning and booking can be done as early as possible to reduce costs.

When it comes to the design project, some students have had troubles with the working hours, which points at the need of a discussion about how to plan and carry out a design project. Still, the course Design Project – Composition and Materiality is on an advanced level and it is important to have project and studio skills to feel comfortable in the process.

Over all the students as well as the teachers have enjoyed the discussion climate in the course. Thank you all for your efforts and contributions that have made the course to a journey into deeper knowledge in landscape architecture!

Student representatives comments

The overall impression from the students is that this has been a highly informative course, full of useful content and assignments. Starting with the lightscape and soundscape workshops was appreciated, as you quickly got to know the class and the course. In general, the students felt that the focus on practical/physical work was a great way of learning and engaging with the course material.

The workload was at times heavy, and a lot of the students pointed out the importance of starting the assignments early as well as planning your work well. The overlapping case place study and design project were especially criticized for the lack of time, although both of those assignments were appreciated individually. There was also some confusion regarding the final design project as some of the students were unsure as to what they were supposed to produce.

The field trip to Stockholm was also highly appreciated. Many liked that there was a list of optional places to visit in the city, although a few of the students felt that there was not enough time during the trip to visit the different sites, read the literature, and do the assignments. Since the students are paying for the trip themselves it is also important that the details are announced early during the course so that there is time to plan accommodation etc.

Altogether, this course and its individual components have been highly informative and engaging. There has been a large focus on thrift and sustainability, which was appreciated by the students, and the literature was interesting to read. The teachers encouraged discussion and created a comfortable atmosphere, which together with the practical nature of the course work encouraged active participation in a way that the students really enjoyed.
