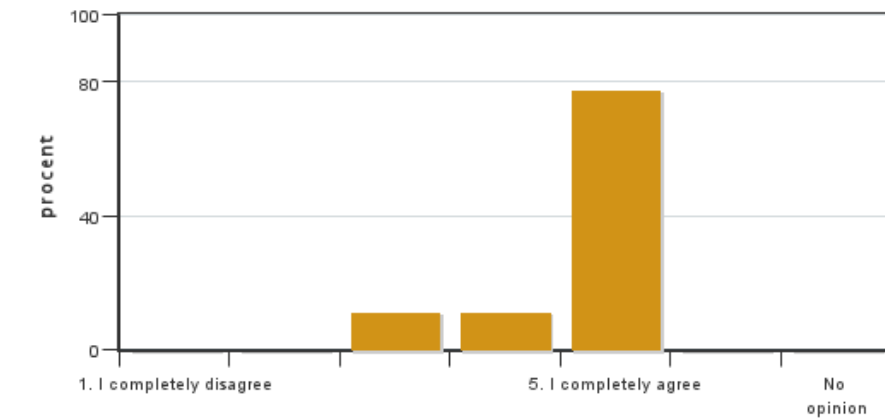

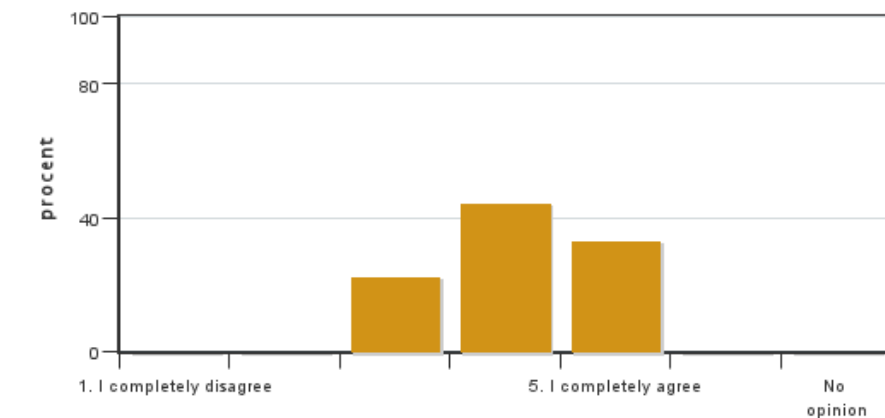

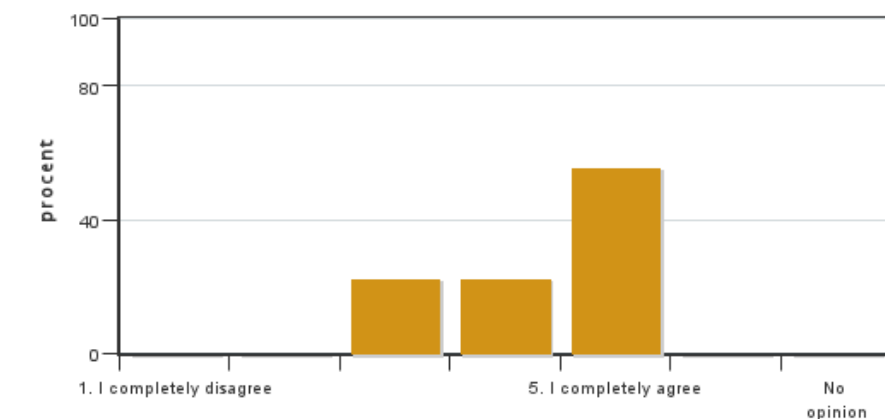

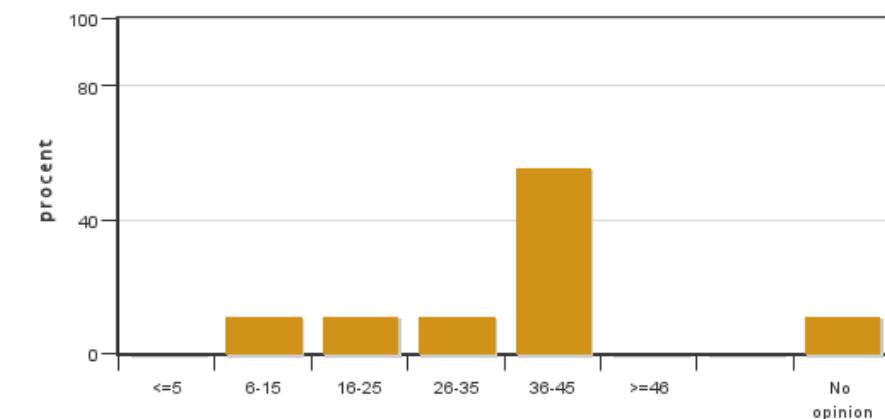

Course leaders comments

Course leader comments LK0403 The Cultural Heritage of Landscape Architecture

I thought that the course went well over all, very good and interested students. They could take a challenge and when not understanding or not approving they came back to me directly. Unfortunately there was a lot of illnesses both among students and teachers, partly due to the pandemic with late bloom of influenzas. This made some lectures disappear and impossible to schedule presentations ahead.

Having the possibility to work with a municipality (Development task) that set the schedule the Society task was moved to the end of the course. This was not good since it covered general aspects of cultural heritage that fits better in the beginning. Unfortunately I did not understand this until it happened.

I am frustrated that I did not come out with comments on assignments earlier than I did, to take in comments one need to remember what was done and that is difficult being active in a new project. (Note to self: write this in my calendar so I do not do other things).

Comments on students answers and comments of a more negative character:

- Q12 Time spent: During some of the group work I found that the students did not take the opportunity for supervision but felt they were finished the assignment before time and tasks like this could always be worked with more. The pedagogic includes open assignments in need of supervision. I shall make group supervision

mandatory next time.

- Three different days of Society task seminars was too much: I agree. 1) I did not adapt this to the amount of students starting the course, 2) Some students were ill and could not present on any of the provided times.
- Seminar on paper writing brain storming wanted: This was provided but few students participated.
- Knowing about the Final task ahead: The students got all of the other tasks from the beginning but I did not want them to think about this until they had done all the other work since it was a reflection assignment.
- Final task unnecessary: A personal and understandable comment but the point was to learn not only about cultural heritage in LA but also learn how to plan a workshop. This since landscape architects work a lot with participatory planning and to actually plan this is not as easy as it seems. This learning goal could have been highlighted more.
