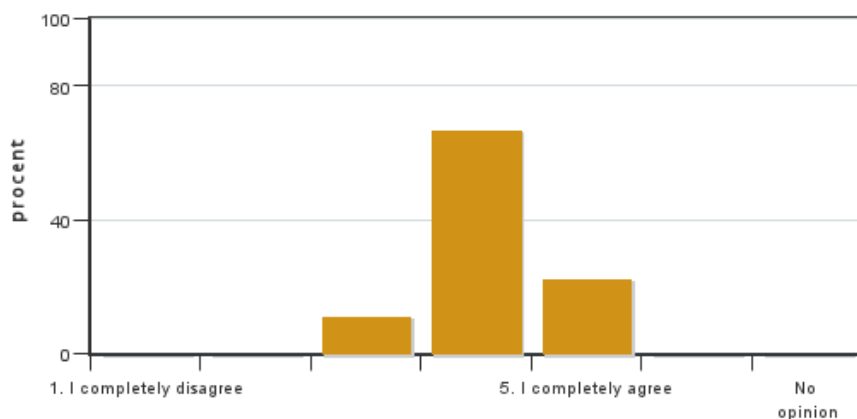

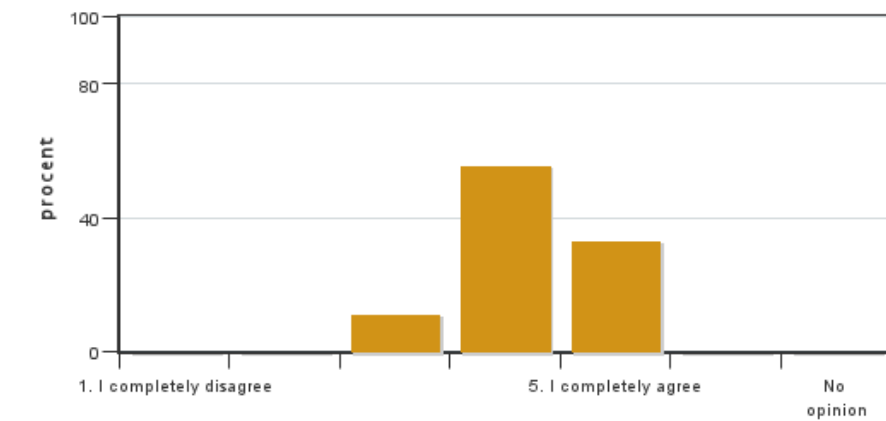

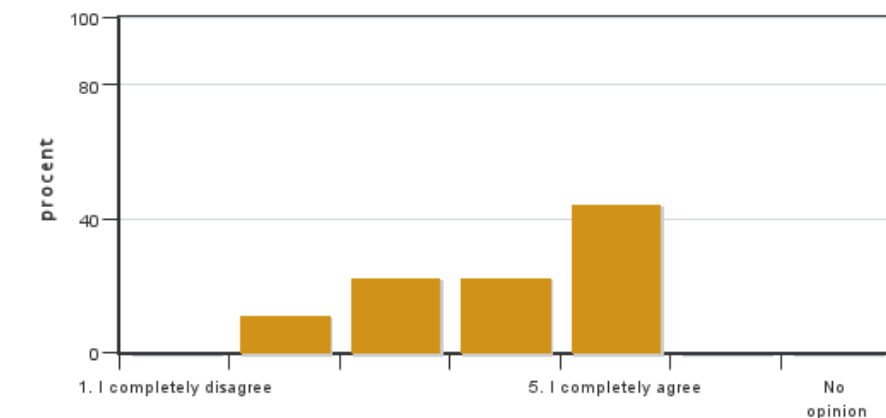

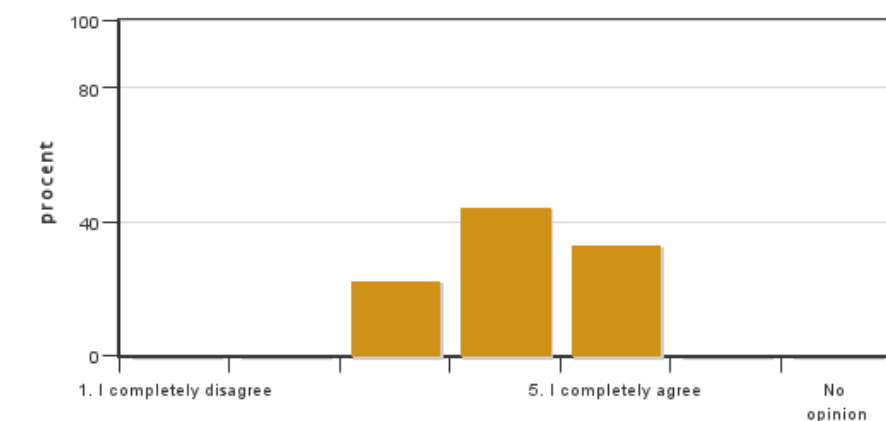

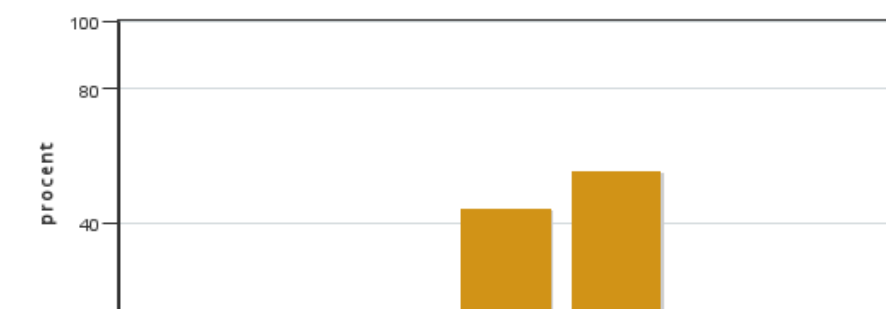

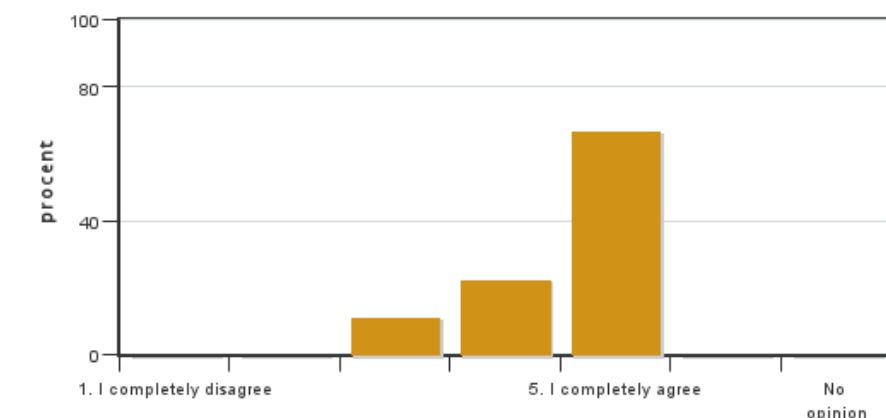

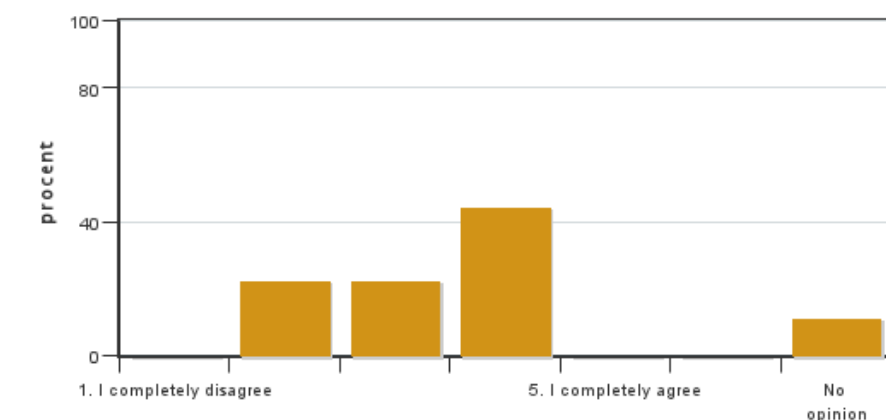

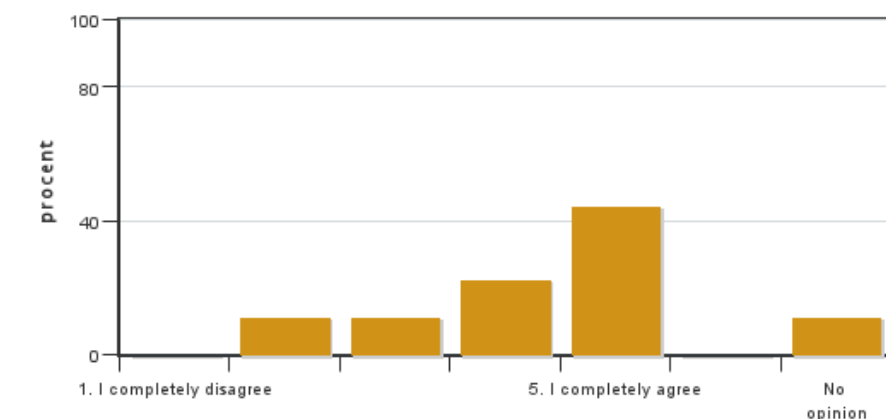

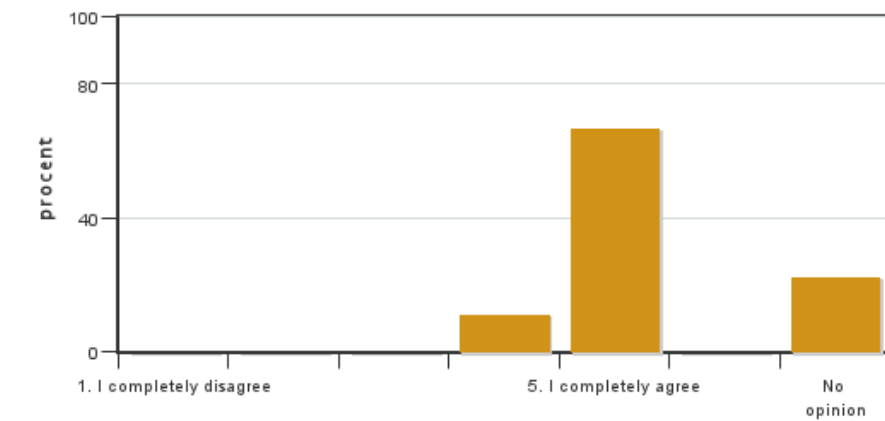

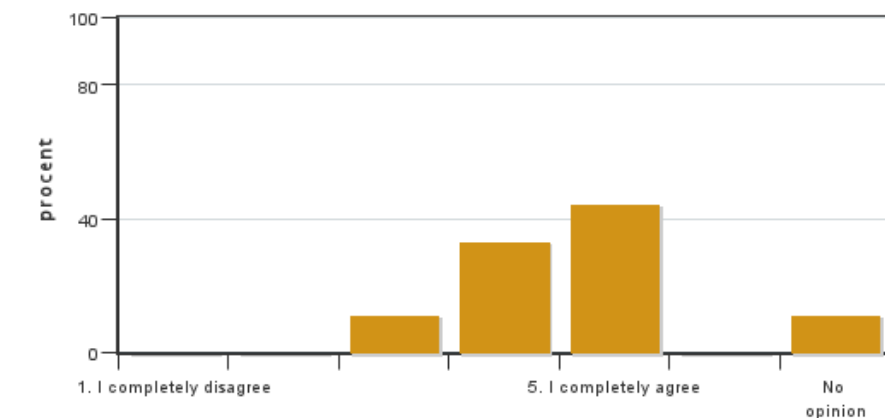

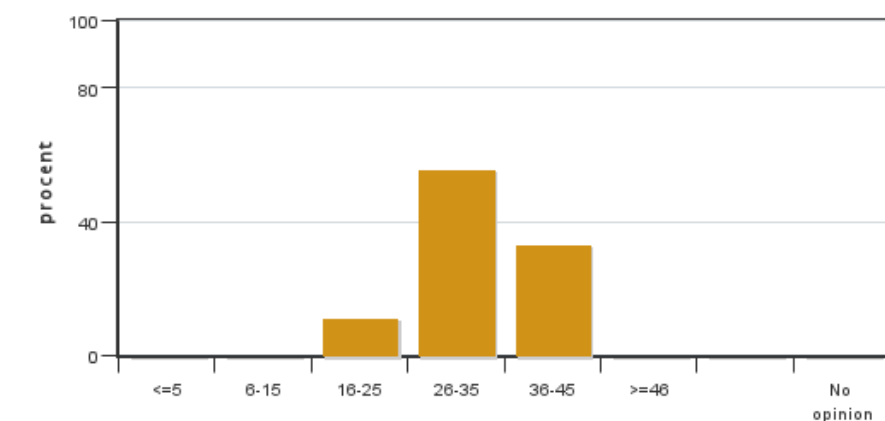

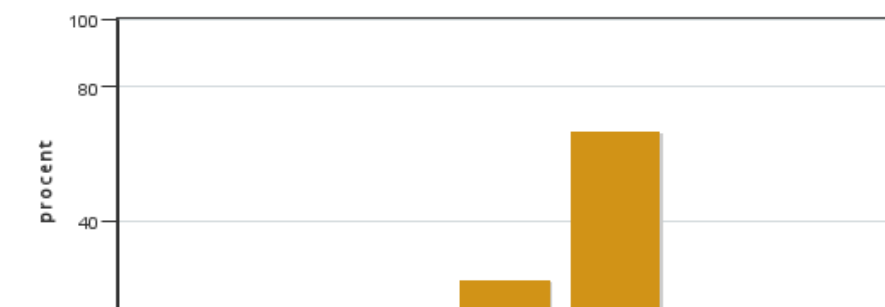

Student representatives comments

The course "Plant food science" (LV0114) has generally received positive feedback from us students. With an overall impression at 4,1/5 and 60 % answer frequency on the evaluation, it is safe to say that us students liked the course. However, as always there are some things that are worth lifting and things that can be improved and/or considered next time the course is held:

Lectures: The students generally thought the lectures were good and learned a lot from them. However, some students thought it was hard to tell what the main message of each lecture was. A solution to this is to have summary slides at the end of each lecture, with text explaining the main points/take home messages of the lecture.

Exam: The exam got a lower score than most other parts of the course from the students. This mainly stems from that many students thought that the material of the exam questions corresponded little with what was brought up on the course.

Studying from distance: Many students thought that lecture worked well from distance. However, several students pointed out that it was harder to concentrate and they were less prone to ask questions over distance/ZOOM.

Quiz: The students generally liked the quizzes and thought it was a good preparation for exam. However, some students thought the extra points for exam part made it stressful and saw little point in it.

Course literature: Students liked the cereal book and thought it was helpful.

Abstract writing: Student thought the abstract writing and subsequent seminars was good for learning to read scientific paper more critically.

Baking and RVA labs: The students really liked the labs and thought they were very helpful in their learning.

Study visit: A student came with the suggestion to have study visit, which would be a nice addition for the future now when covid restrictions seem to be over.
