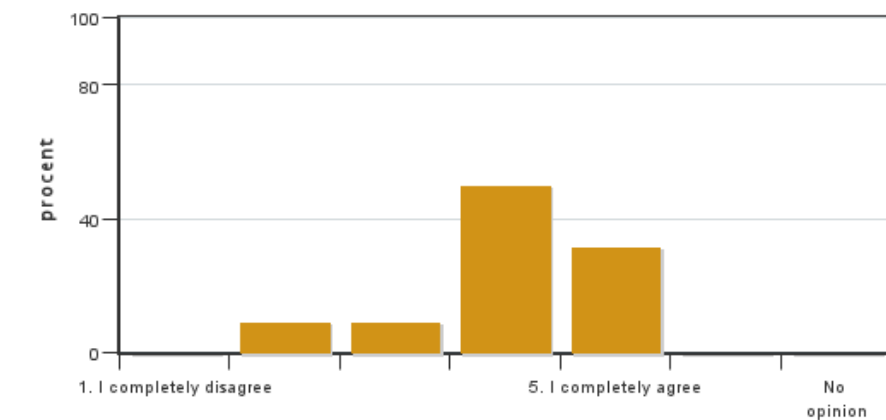

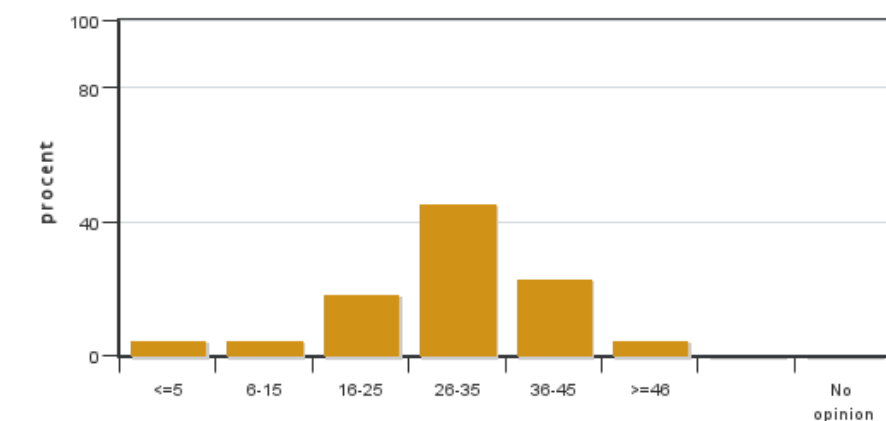

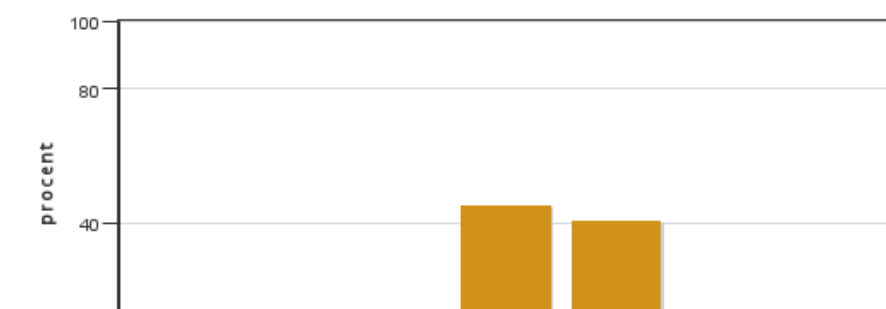

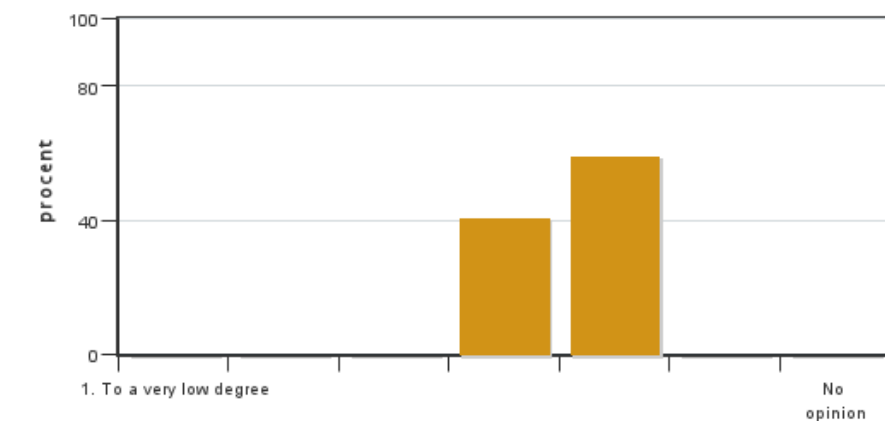

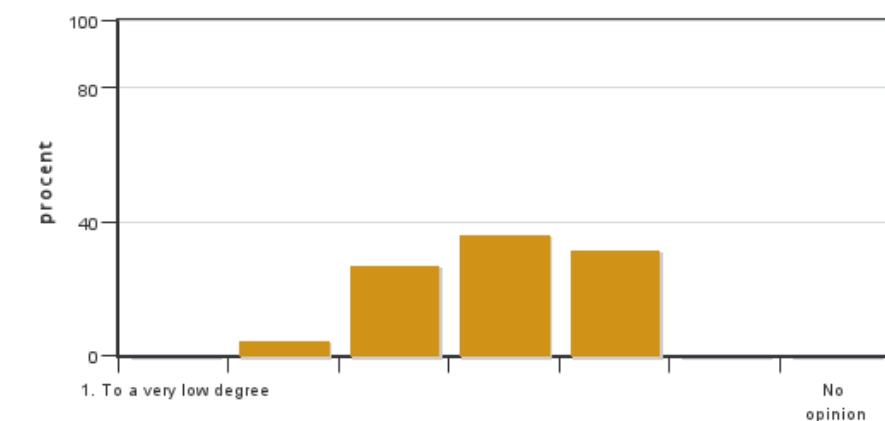

17. Have the study visit assignment helped you in your learning process?

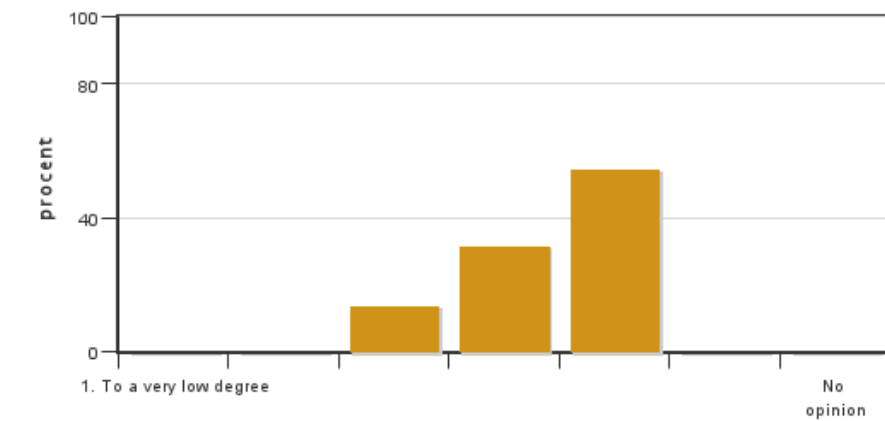

18. Have the quantification project helped you in your learning process?

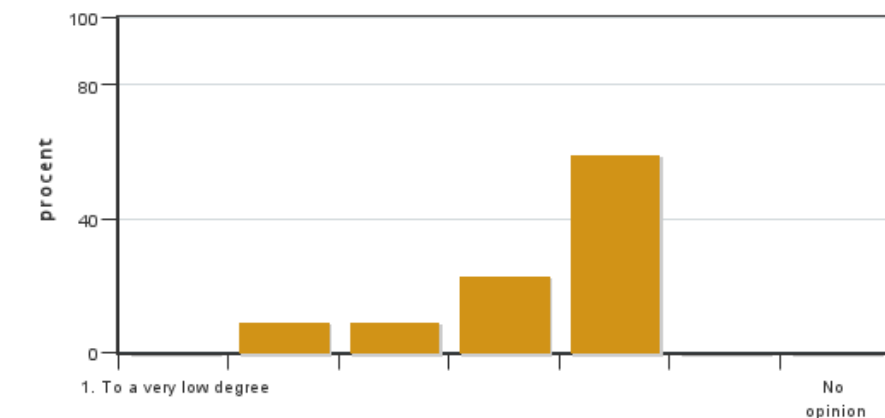

Course leaders comments

In general the course was well received among the students that answered the course evaluation, it was even improved slightly in comparison with last year. Based on this the changes should be introduced carefully so that improvements do not shift the overall balance of the course. However, there are aspects that can be improved and the course team plan to do the following improvements for the course next year:

- Highlight the rules around plagiarism i the course introduction.
- Keep the study visit format with individual study visits, even though this was developed for pandemic times.
- Return to campus to make interactions easier.
- There was to little social science perspectives in the course, probably due to the fact that one social science lecture had to be canceled. Next year we should consider to have some back up teachers for some key lectures, or record them in advance. However, its a general problem that lectures are very person dependent and that there is only small possibilities to makes shifts in the schedule in a very short course.
- Increase the demand for prior knowledge so that all students on the course actually have the knowledge that is needed to fully participate in an advanced course in food science.
- The information flow can be improved, but some confusion is probably a direct or indirect consequence of pandemic restrictions that puts extra preasure on the course organisation and limits personal meetings.

Student representatives comments

Overall good impressions from everyone with good feedback on the different assignments that in my opinion were well suited for the course to get a better understanding of food waste from different perspectives. Course objectives were clearly mentioned throughout the course.

About the prior knowledge: Given the spread of the scores I suppose it might be good to raise the threshold as mentioned. Prior knowledge of MS Excel seems to be a bit of an issue, but since all the formulas were given to us during the exercise it should be very simple to learn if they just do it a couple of times.

A bunch of people in the course worked or did other courses simultaneously to this course, which in many cases did not work out in their favour as it turned out to be a bit overwhelming. Focusing on this course alone would be recommended.

Canvas was for the bigger part well organised, possibly the lower scores come from people who are not used to Canvas. When last minute changes occur, perhaps you could send out an sms through SLUNIK? That has worked well in other courses and is a very efficient complement to emails and other channels.

The social aspect of sustainable development would be great to have a backup for as mentioned, even a recorded version of the lecture/s would be sufficient.

The lectures worked well on zoom but for some elements, like group introductions and the Excel exercise, it would have been better to be on campus.
