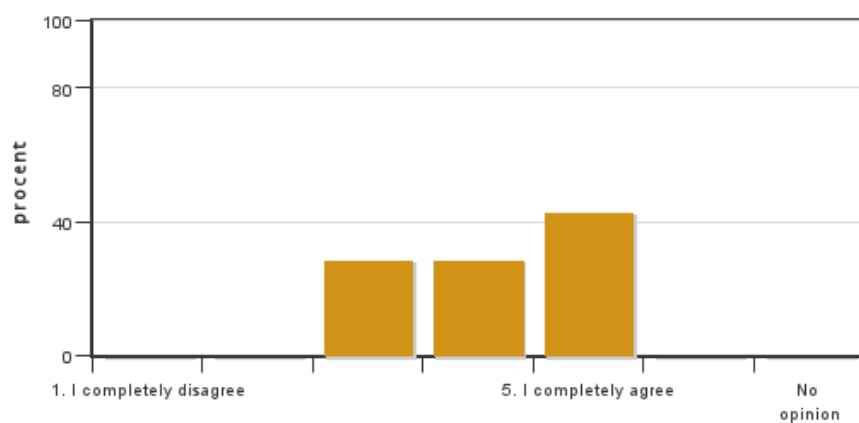

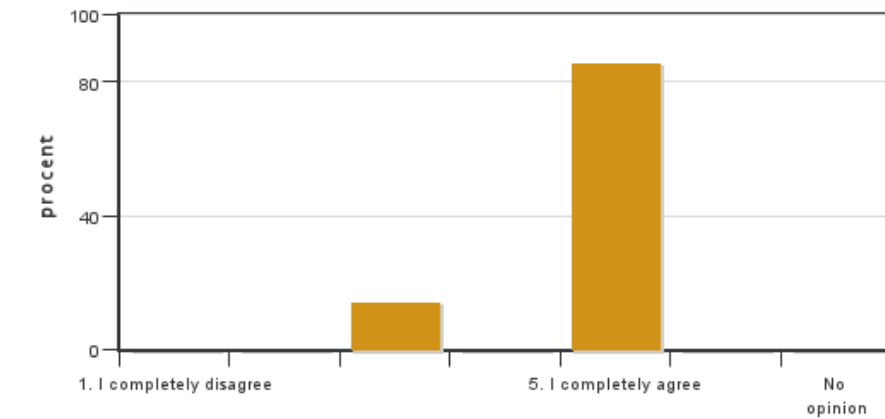

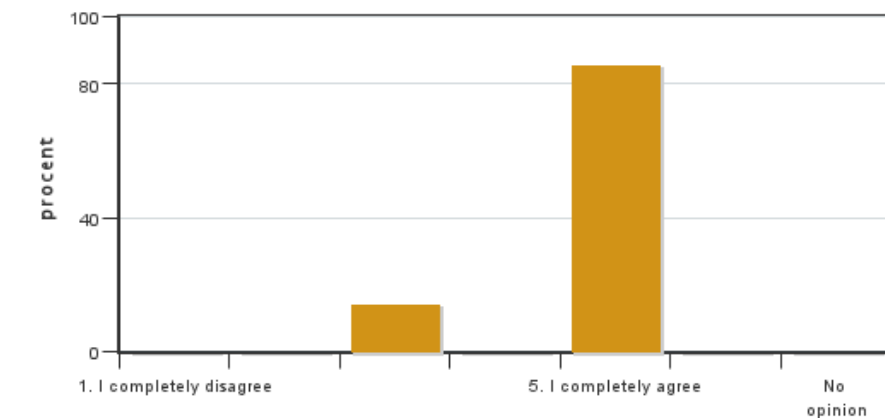

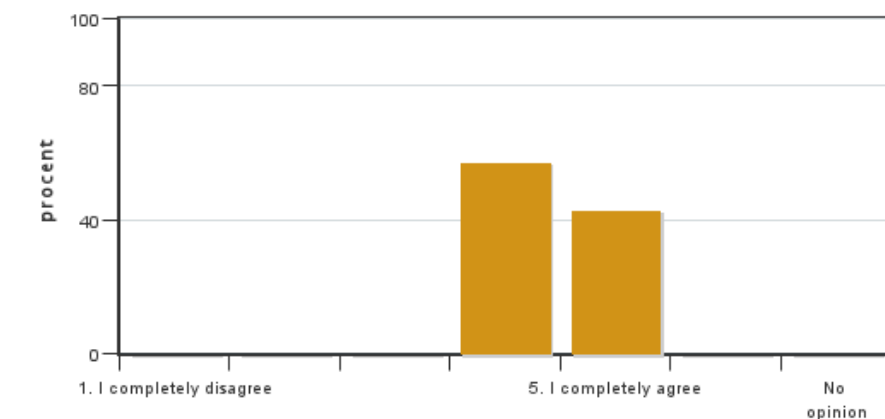

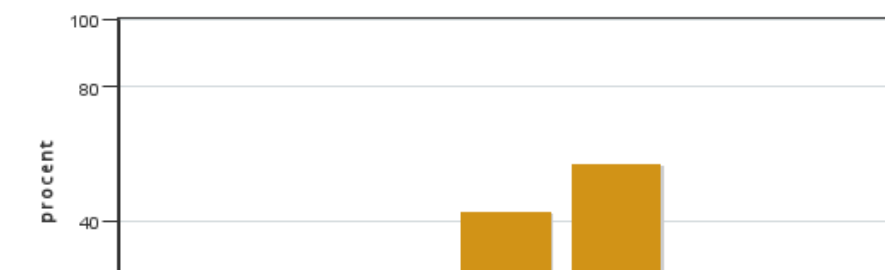

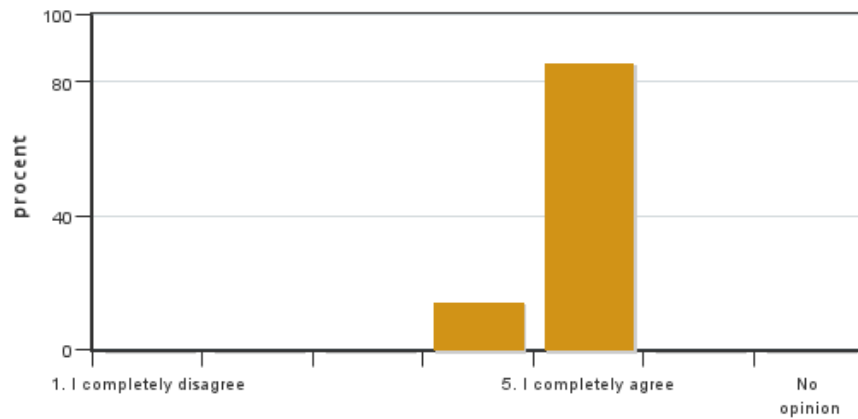

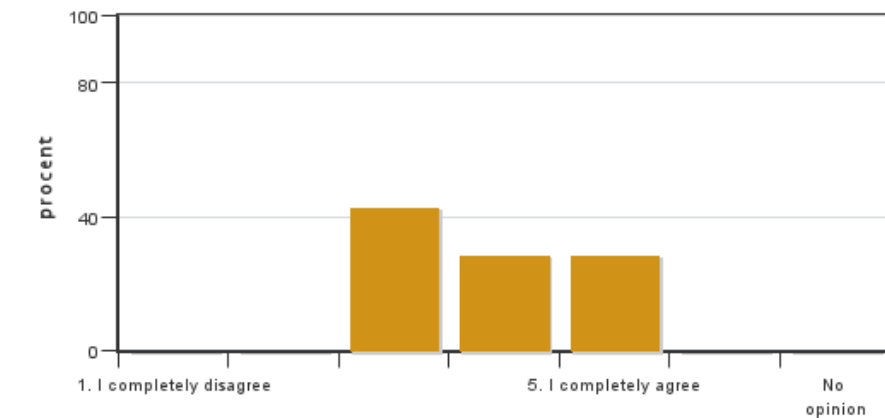

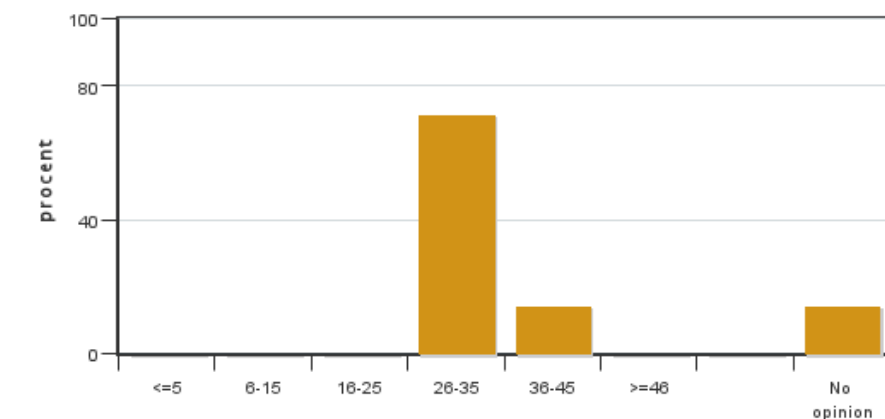

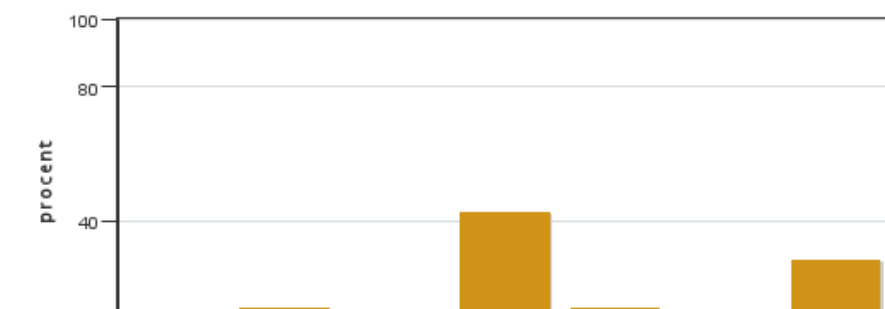

For the course, Engaging critically with environmental governance practices, 25 students took part in the course. The answer frequency was 28%. The overall impression of the course was very good, and well structured. There have been some opinions about the workshop with the stakeholders that it was a little messy and not so well organized, but overall the impression was good, and it mostly matched the content of the course. Going in more deeply to lectures, course literature, and exercises, they have been an excellent support to the students. Some students could even better relate to the previous texts from previous courses. Overall the students of 2021 find the class very good, and there is a happy atmosphere in the group. What is not to love with a university that scores a five as a median when it comes to if the learning environment has been a satisfactory. Many students find the course interesting but wish it could be more topics to choose between or work with to get more ideas and connect them to their readings and tasks.
