It sounds like students were generally happy with the course and its structure. I will consider for next year if there is a better way to structure the thesis proposal part of the course so that it is more closely tied to the other parts of the course.

Student representatives comments

Environmental Policy is an independent course with the focus on environmental policies to manage scare recourses and sustainable development . A good number of students enrolled for the course having different background such as Agricultural Economics and Environmental Economics. The content of the course was designed to fit in both degrees. Five students responded to the student evaluation as mentioned above. The overall impression of the course was good as students found it very interesting. Students were more on the same page that the content of the course had clear link with the course objectives, whereas the thesis proposal was felt bit disjointed with the course maybe due to more focus on econometrics even though the topics were about environmental policy. The students were quite satisfied with their prior knowledge that helped in better understanding of the course. The course material was easily accessible that is really time saving for students. The combination of lectures, exercises and seminars in a balanced way supported the learning outcomes of the course. The paper selection for seminar was a great activity. Every paper had new and interesting environmental issue that added in the knowledge of the students.

The overall environment of the classes was satisfactory in terms of facilities and equipment needed except for the facility of door opening for the special needs of the students. The course leader has maintained inclusive social environment in the class, while respecting each other's opinion. The students agreed that the examination provided them with the opportunity to demonstrate their understanding of the course. The course has also covered sustainable development aspect which has been admired by the students. As per students, they were satisfied with the international aspect of the course, which can be improved further. Apart from the evaluation, the discussion with students ended up with good remarks about the course as in whole. The course leader was very humble, gentle and student friendly. There were many interactive sessions held in the classroom that made the lectures even more interesting.
