























Course leaders comments

The course has worked well, and the students' overall impression has been good-very good (4,3 on average based on 12 respondents - 66% of the course participants). Overall, the students that completed the evaluation were very positive regarding the links between the course content and the learning objectives, the course organization and administration, the social learning environment, gender and equality aspects, sustainable development and international perspectives. We are thrilled that the students have appreciated the course.

I have met with both the student representative and the teachers in charge of each module to discuss the course evaluation. Based on these discussions, we have come up with some action points to improve the course further:

- The students appreciated the diverse set of assignments in the course and the assignments themselves (factfulness, infographic, interview project etc), so we will keep these for coming years. However, we might modify the examination system to make individual grades less dependent on group work.
- During each assignment presentation, the teacher in charge of the assignment will go through the assignment rubric in detail, clarify the specific grading criteria and discuss expectations and high standards.
- We will have a half-time meeting with the student representative to get students' feedback.
- In each module, we will include a time slot to discuss in depth the literature related to that module.
- We will increase the number of pre-recorded lectures as students really appreciated these (they liked the fact that they could prepare well in advance of the follow-up discussions watch the videos, read literature, prepare questions etc)
- Some students missed the social connection and interactions, which is of course one of the drawbacks of
 online courses. Next year we will try to organize live gatherings in the different hubs (Umeå, Alnarp etc) so that
 the students can meet some of their course fellows.
- The students appreciated we used Mural and Mentimeter, so we will continue doing that next year.
