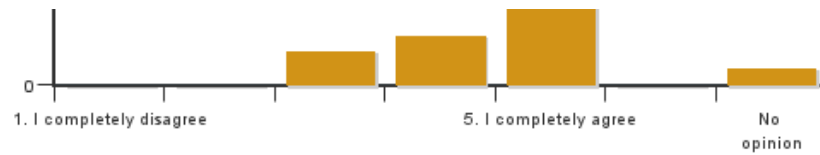

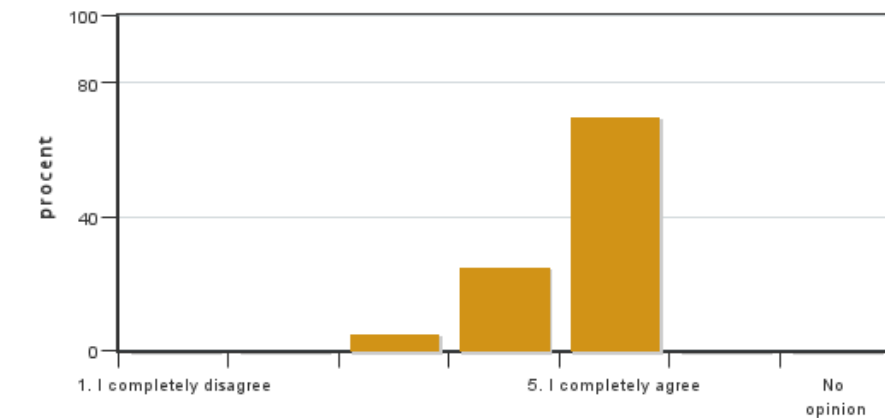

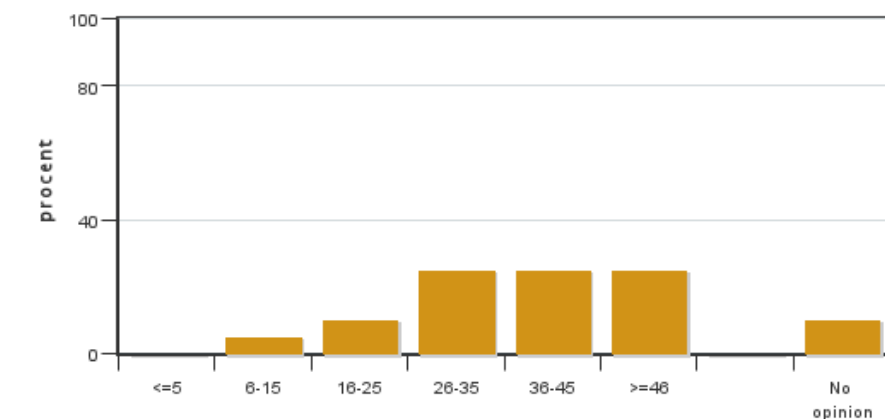

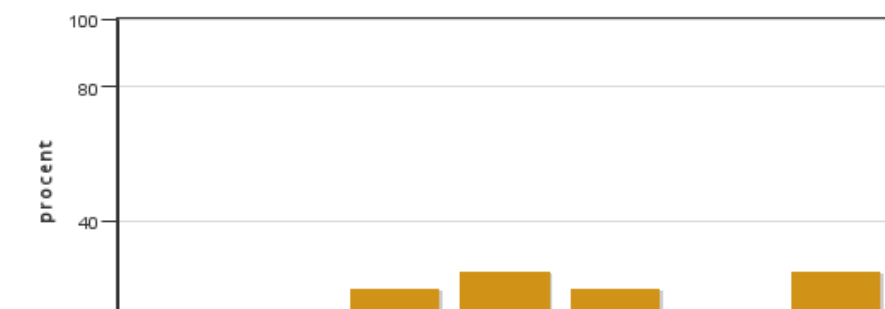

Student representatives comments

The overall impression of the course was pretty good (3,5/5. Median 4). Students thought it gave a good insight into the field of research and theory in Landscape Architecture and an understanding of the relationship between theory, practice and methodology.

The literature was extensive in this course, and some students felt that it was a bit overwhelming. Many students thought that there should have been much more practical exercises in connection to the theories. There could have been a greater variety in the tasks given throughout the course, to balance the reading.

Students thought the lectures given were good, but some could have been more connected to the texts and the final paper. Some students found that the literature and the lectures did not prepare them enough for the final writing assignment.

The overall impression of the literature seminars was good, they were well structured and helped with gaining a deeper understanding of the texts. The fika provided was well appreciated :-)

Overall, the students thought the online sessions worked well, even if the sessions on campus were more appreciated. Some students wished there had been more on-campus time in December, although this did enable students to go home for Christmas which was good.

The office visits were much appreciated, and students wished there would have been many more!

Students found the final writing assignment to be a very good task and good practice in writing, but the time to write it could have been extended. The supervision and final seminar was good, but there could have been more exercises earlier in the course to help to prepare for the writing.

Students spent on average 35h/week on the course, but more in the final weeks during the final assignment.
