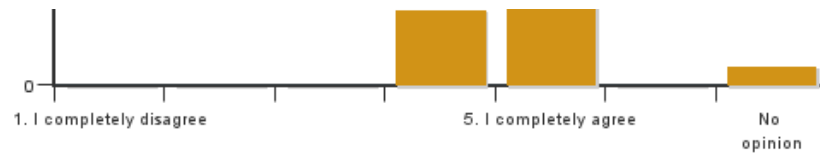

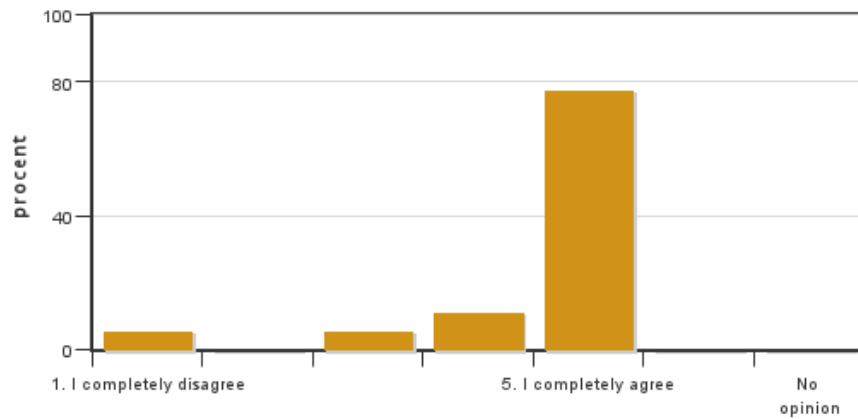

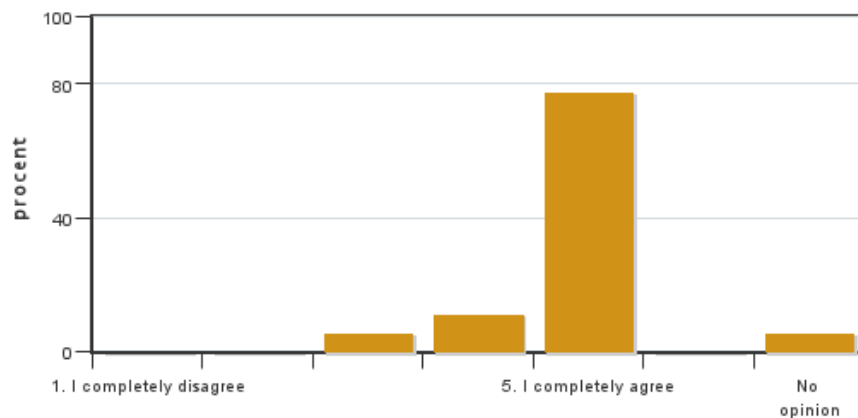

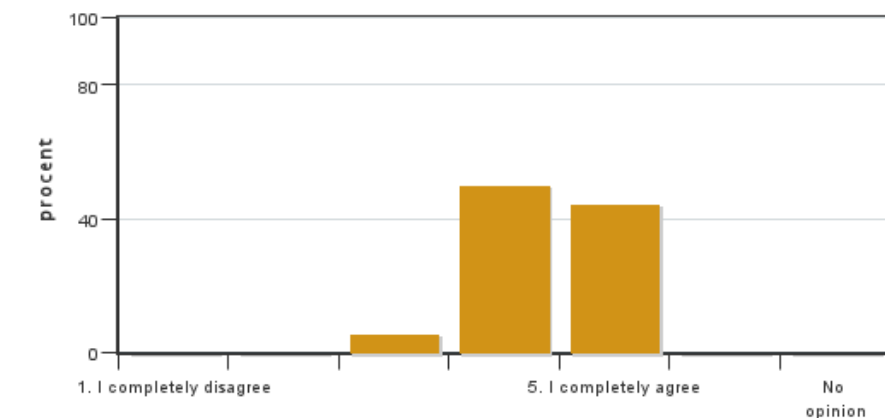

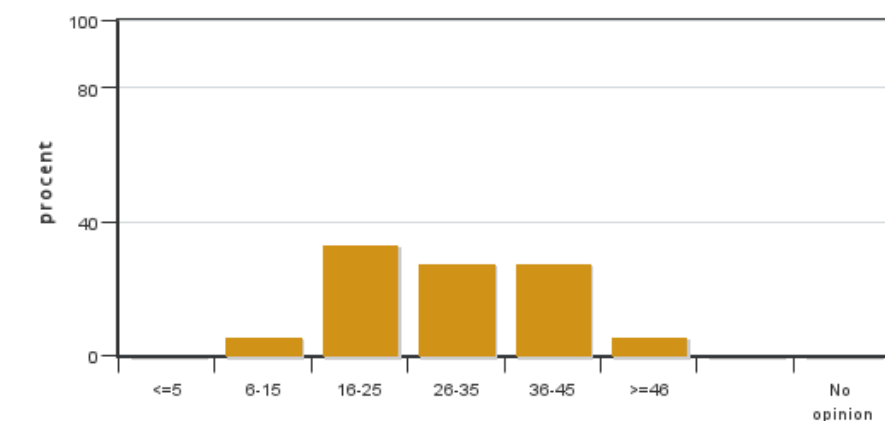

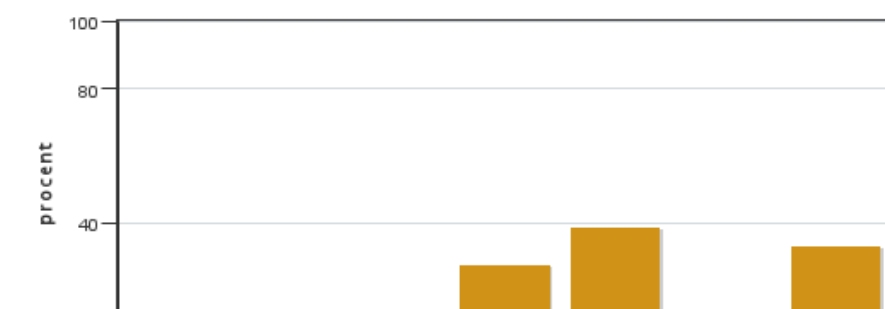

## Course leaders comments

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The following comments and reflections are in response to the course evaluation of participating students from the course locations Uppsala and Alnarp. The answering rate for the course evaluation 2023 was 90% in Uppsala and 100% in Alnarp. The course was held for the fifth time.

Based on the students comments and suggestions from 2022, we have adapted the group project work into a policy brief exercise. This was well received by this years students, encouraging us to further develop this group project for the coming years.

In addition to the meet the author session we have integrated research insights sessions into this years schedule. This was also well received and a valuable addition to the theoretical lectures.

We will further increase the number of lectures held from campus Alnarp. The idea of at least one joint excursion during the course will be considered.

We will continue our work on aligning the lecture contents in order to avoid any overlap where it is not necessary.

## Student representatives comments

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The course "Plant Production from Molecular to Field Scale" was well organized and well planned. All students indicated they had a positive impression about the course, the course material was easily accessible and the lectures were easy to follow and interactive. Majority of the students indicated they spent at least 30 hours per week on the course. The physical learning environment was excellent and timely especially with the online lectures. The course covers both local and international perspectives with case studies from Europe, US, UK, Africa and Asia. The group project helps us to apply and better understand key concepts from the course and the intended learning outcomes were clear and comprehensible. Meet the author sessions was much appreciated and all students indicated they were able to demonstrate what they learned during the exams. However, the duration of the exams (3hrs) was quite short. The timely release of results after exams (24 hrs) was much appreciated by all students. The course leader was always available for questions and always inquires if everything is going on well with the course. The course planning, teaching and everything was excellent.
