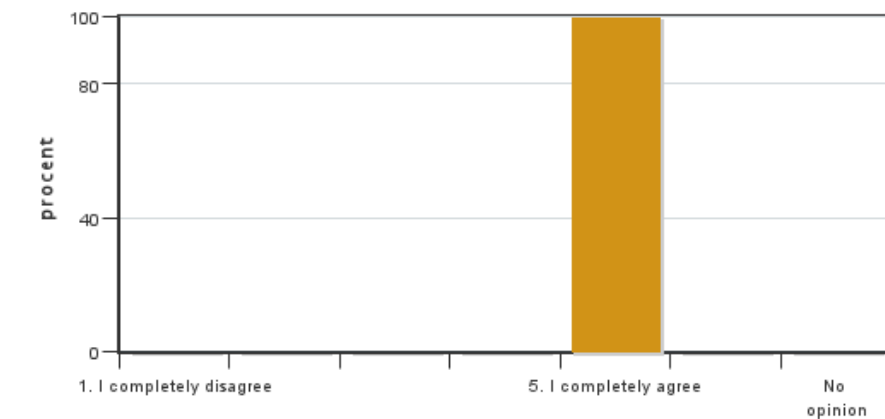

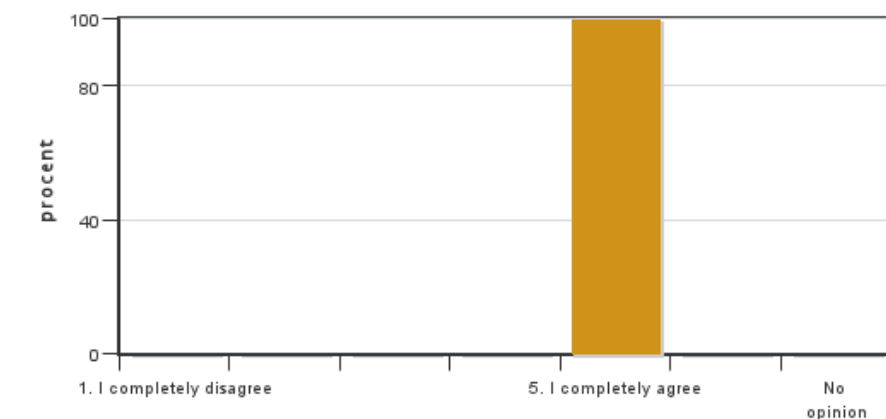

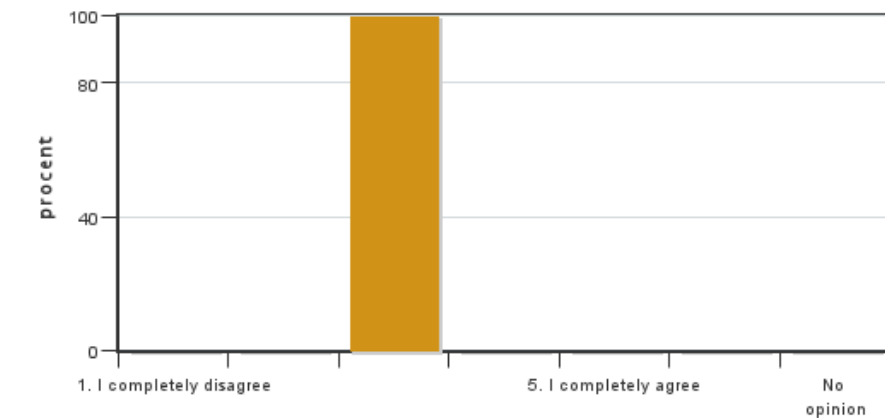

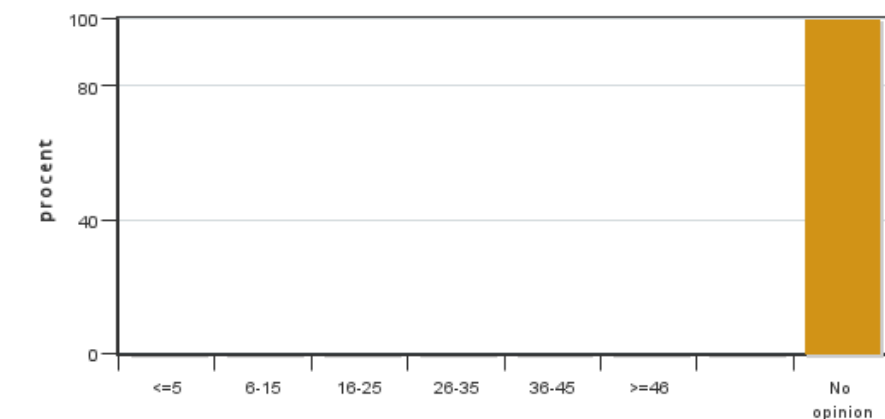

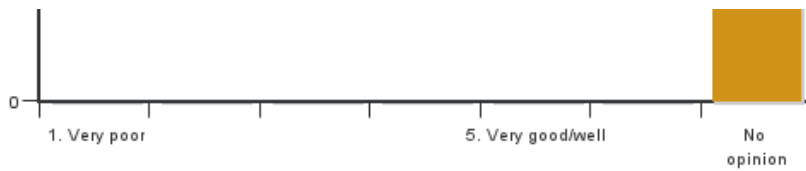

Below, You will find the summary of brief interviews I had with students who took the course during the related semester.

Overall, students enjoyed the course and stated that they appreciated how complex ideas were presented clearly making everyone understand them. Together with the teaching of the course, they also find assignments/practical applications very helpful to learn in a more fun and permanent way.

And when it's come to how to improve the course, students pointed out different issues:

- Coordination between instructors could be improved.
 - This comment refers to the use of different programs (STATA & Excel), and similarities between lectures 4 and 5 regarding the content.
- There could be more emphasis on practical application.
 - Here the case study could be less straightforward and have a higher weight on the final grade.
 - The part with Monte Carlo simulations could also include practical application done by/with students.
- Monte Carlo simulations part could be structured better.
 - Several students stated that their expectations and the course content didn't match regarding Monte Carlo simulations. Hence, more time and practical application can be dedicated for Monte Carlo simulations in the future.
