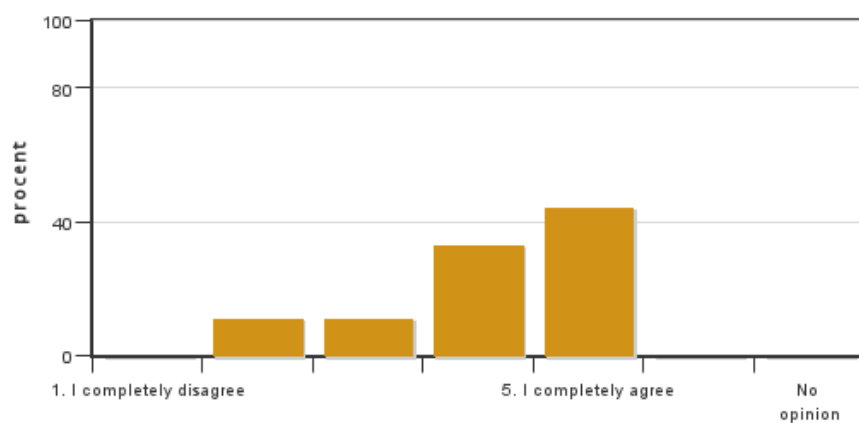

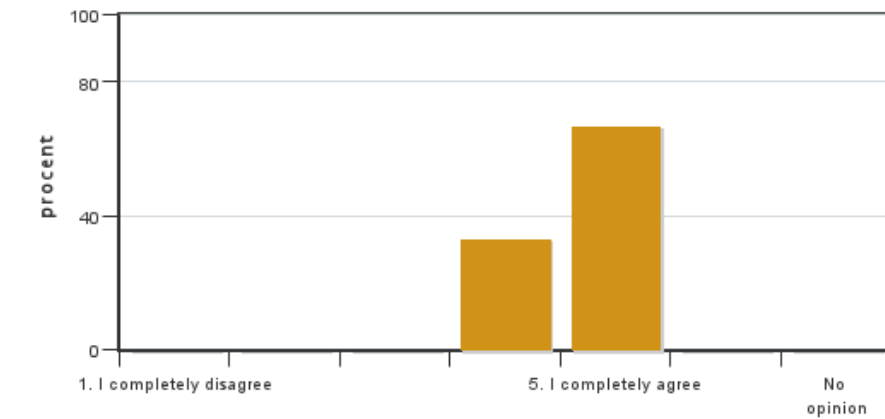

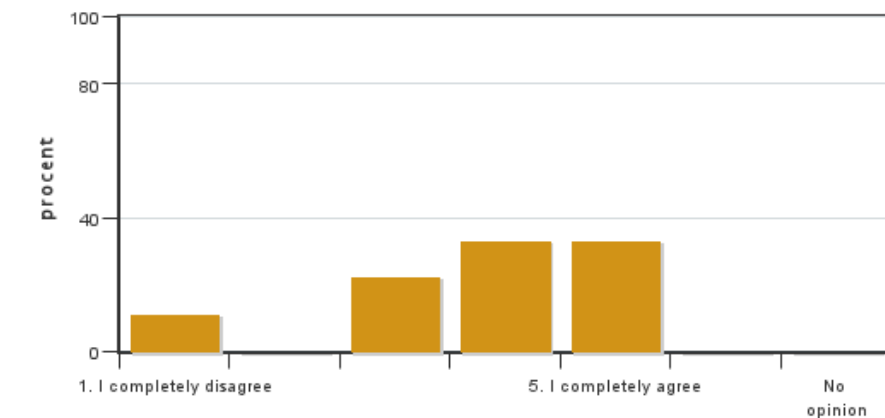

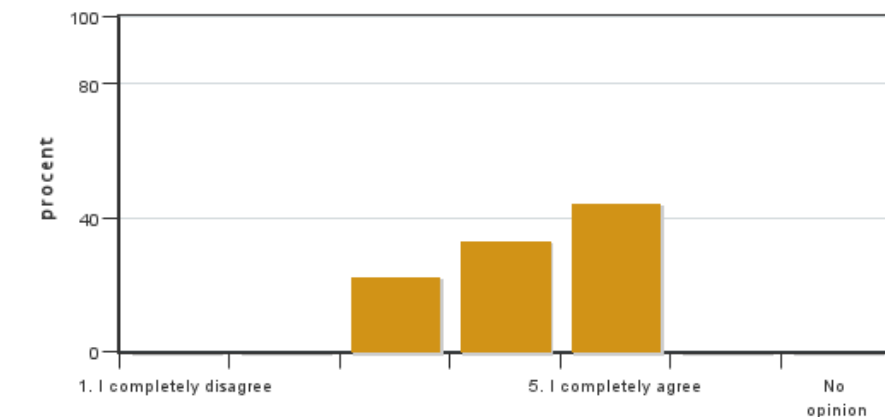

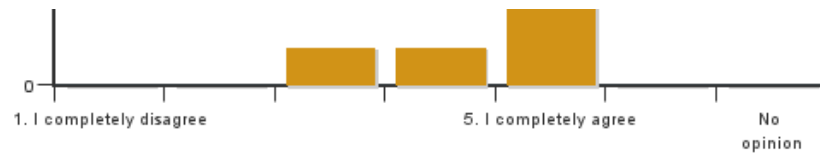

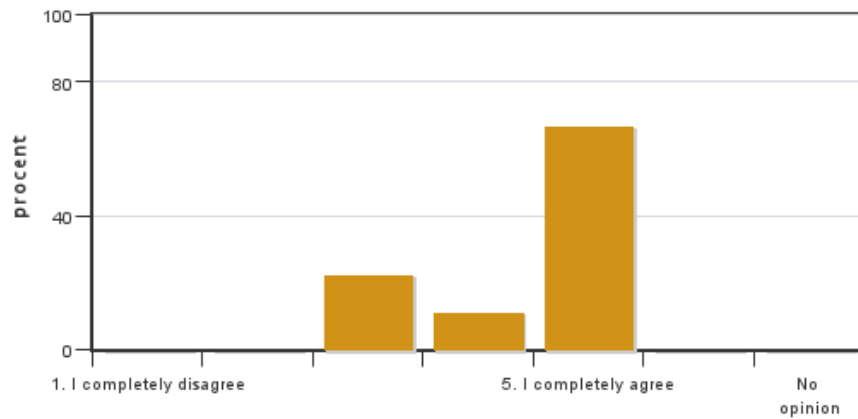

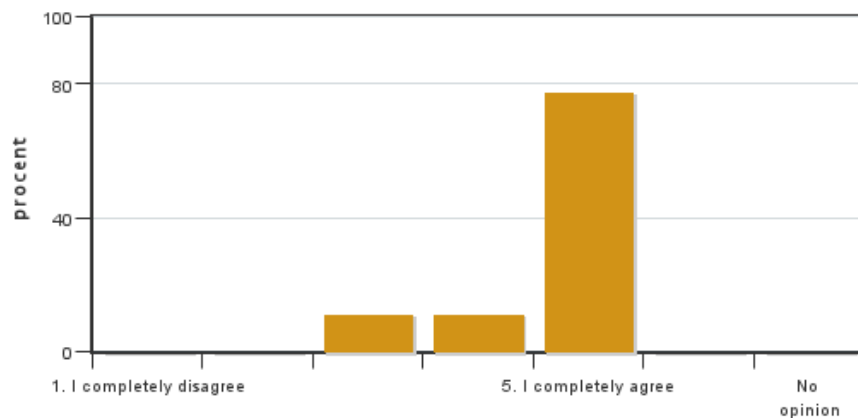

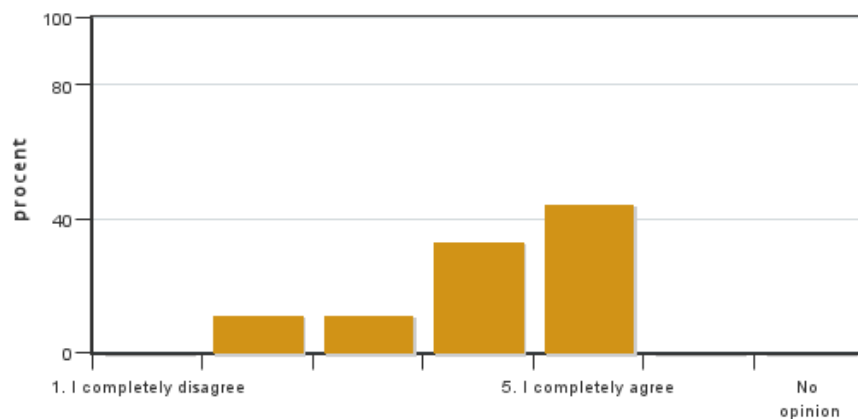

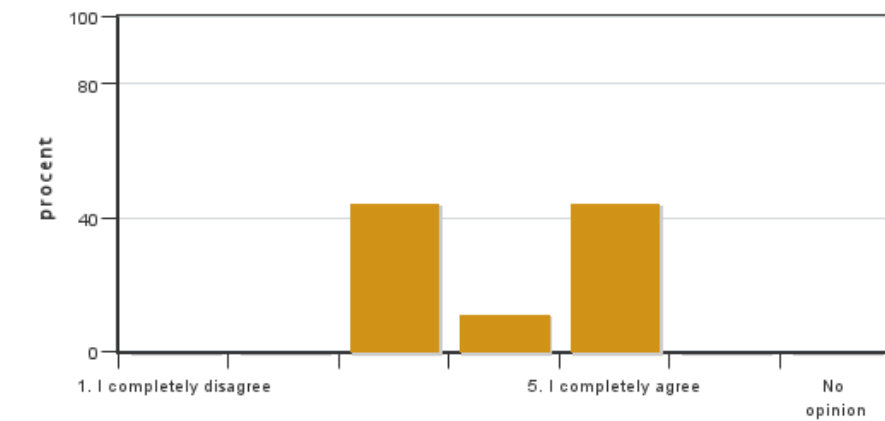

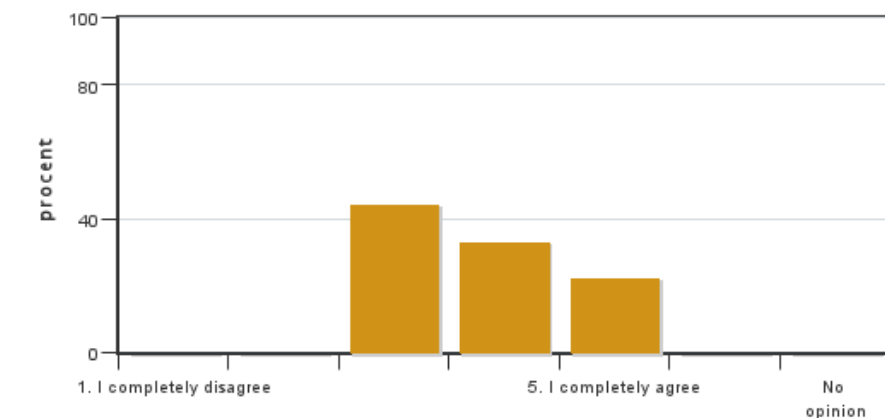

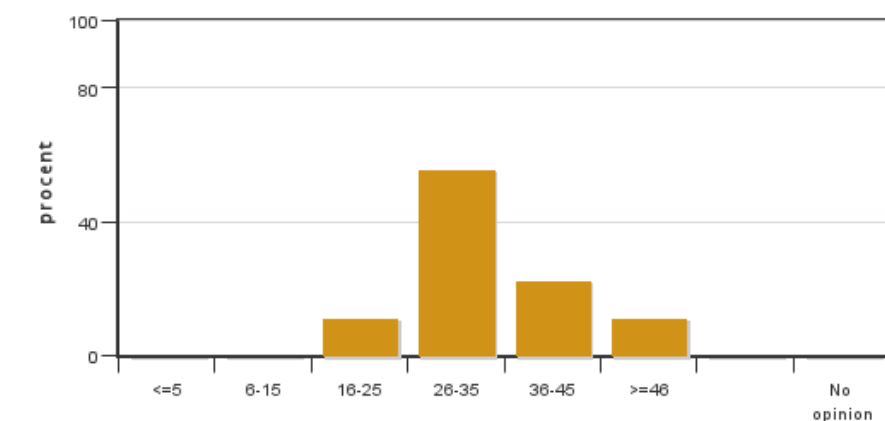

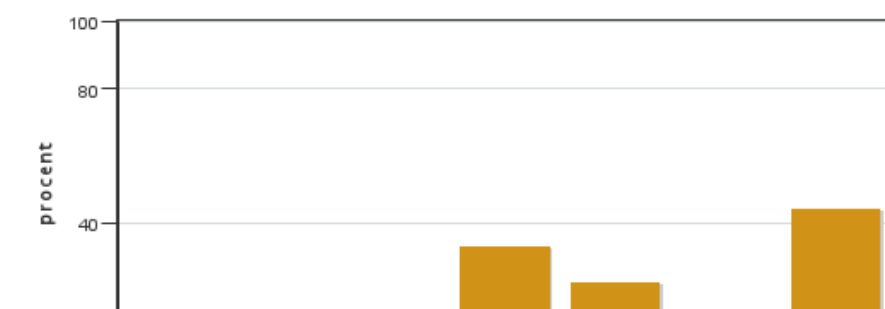

Course leaders comments

Of 19 students who attended the course, 9 (47%) completed the course evaluation, although all students in the course received reminders to do the evaluation.

Overall, the students who answered the evaluation seem to have considered the course a good one. The overall impression of the course got an average of 4.0. Over the different questions in the course evaluation, most questions received good marks with only two of the questions getting an average score below 4.0.

One of the question that got an average below 4.0 was concerning the availability of information about the course that received an average of 3.8. We course leaders see this as still ok, as it was the first time the course leaders worked together on this course. There were, however, not many specific comments concerning what was lacking and the students had the opportunity to ask questions in a forum on Canvas throughout the course. We still, however, bring such aspects with us for future courses and will try to improve.

The other question the received an average below 4.0 was whether the course covered international perspectives that received an average of 3.8. Due to the nature of the course, part of the course closer linked to e.g. society were more focused on Sweden, as the course was given at a Swedish university. We do think, however, that many international aspects were covered in the course (e.g., some students did internship periods abroad, and aspects concerning animal behaviour and communication with different stakeholders are applicable internationally. Unfortunately, this question did not receive any comments at all that could clarify more specific problems or examples.

The question regarding the students having sufficient prior knowledge for the course, and the question concerning the examinations' ability for the students to show what they have learnt during the course both received very high marks (both got an average of 4.7) which means that the level of the course seems to be on the correct level.

As course leaders, we are specifically happy that the students think that the social learning environment has been inclusive, respecting differences of opinion – this question received an average of 4.7.

Overall, we think that the course went well, and although this was the last time the course was given in this format, we appreciate the students who gave feedback, which will be useful for planning of future courses.

We would like to take the opportunity to thank all students that attended the course and wish them all good luck in their future studies and careers.
