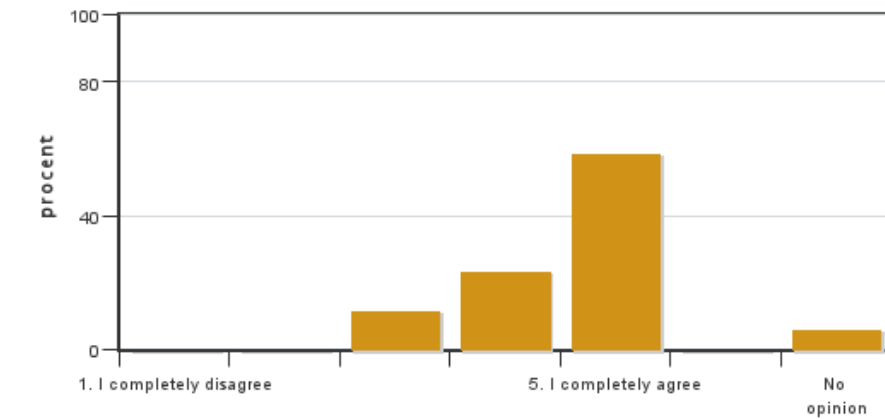

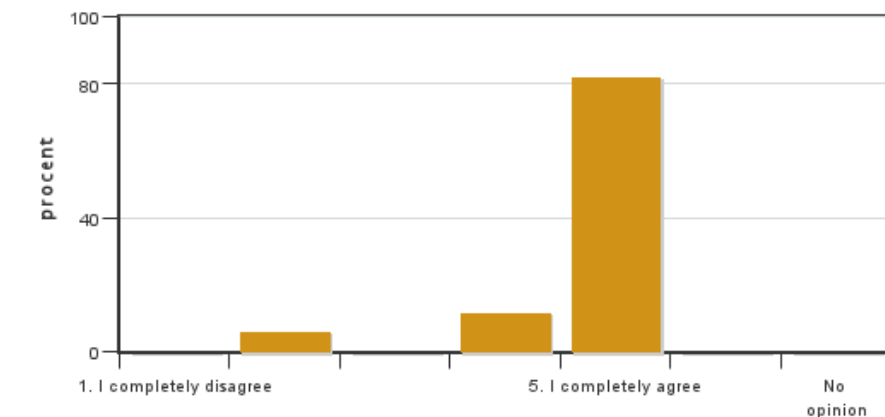

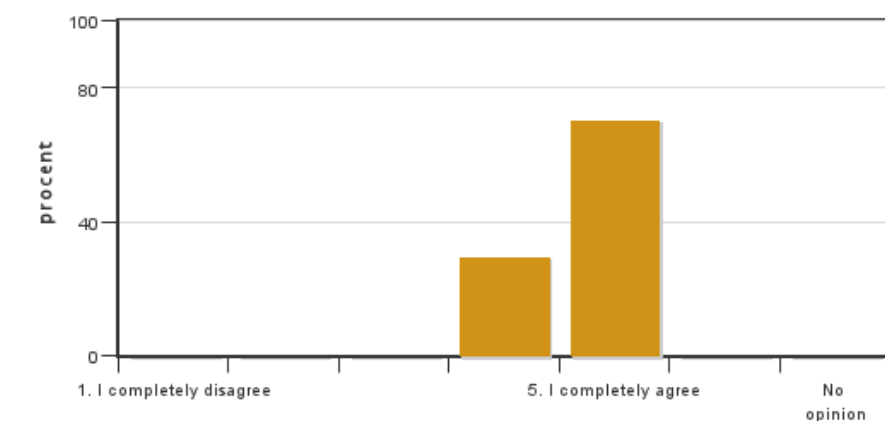

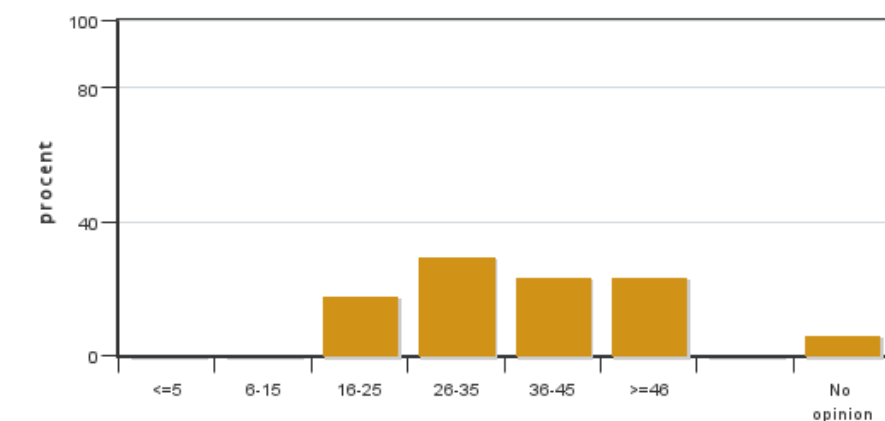

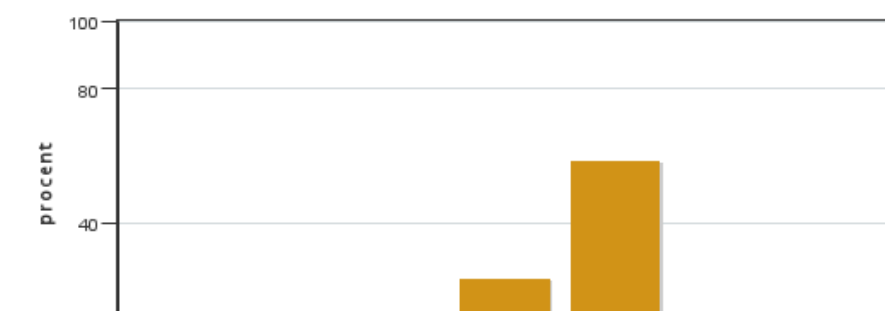

Student representatives comments

As it has been stated in the course leaders comments, the ratings of the course have been very positive. There are almost no negative comments or grades in the course evaluation. Some students expressed their dissatisfaction with online learning but those comments referred to online learning in general, not specifying anything wrong with the distant lectures in this course. The comments about the behavior of students during classes on excursion are a bit too broad to provide any useful feedback while students being too loud at night on excursion could potentially be a topic for further discussions (although to my knowledge the source of noise at night came from other residents of the resort we were staying at). When personally discussing the quality of this course with my course mates I almost never heard any complaints. The diverse cast of lecturers were praised for their knowledge and proficiency with which they can share their knowledge with students. Lecture notes were always on time and all the useful (and other) literature was easily available. One point which could be changed was the trip to the animal enclosure in Białowieża. At least a few students found the bike ride and walk around the zoo to be very unnecessary although the weather conditions contributed a lot to those opinions (maybe it isn't worth going there if it's raining). Apart from that the trip to Poland was a great success. Overall there is nothing more to say than 'keep up the good work' to the course leader and everyone involved in making this course as well organized as it is.
