Overall the course has been well received. The lecturers seem to be very competent in their fields of studies. More lectures in specific subjects like carbon storage credits and economic analyses for multiple use forestry have been requested.

The main complaints from students are on the structure and order of the Canvas page. The lectures and exercises have been in disorder and inconsistently named. Also, some students experienced confusion regarding the level of expected prior knowledge and experienced a lag between what concepts the teachers expect us to have a clear grasp of and our overall prior knowledge in mathematics for example. The literature in the course have been interesting and relevant to the topics of the course.

Over all, the course was good but has potential for improvement.
