

















- Great structure with the three course coordinators, allowing fast communication;
- Different methodologies were presented but sometimes quite abstract for the students;
- The home exam was very well presented, with enough time for execution;
- Literature seminars allowed students to share their own perspectives and understanding of the readings but structured in a way that allowed students to not necessarily contribute actively to the seminar discussions;
- The excursion was a nice opportunity for students to mingle. It felt there was space left for more content to be included during the activities of the day;

- Besides some standard orientations, it was appreciated the freedom given to the
