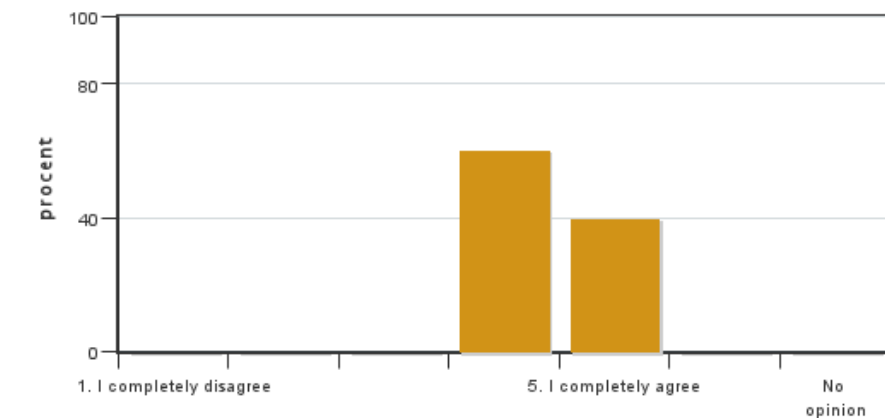

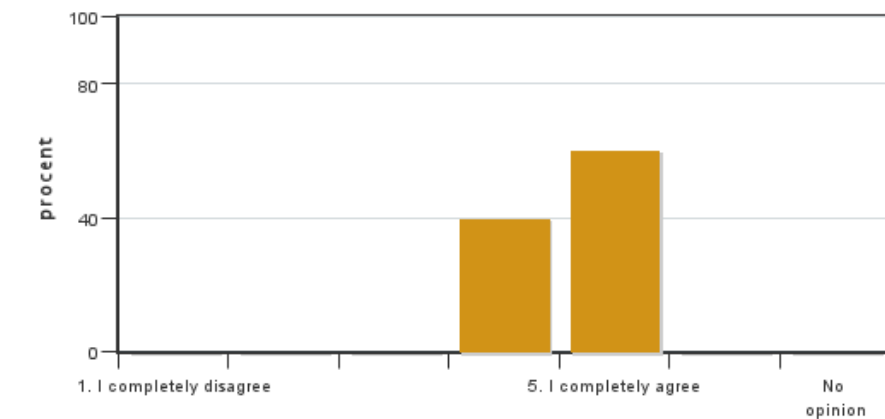

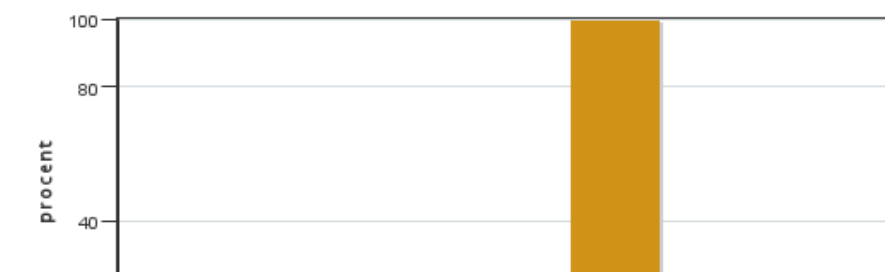

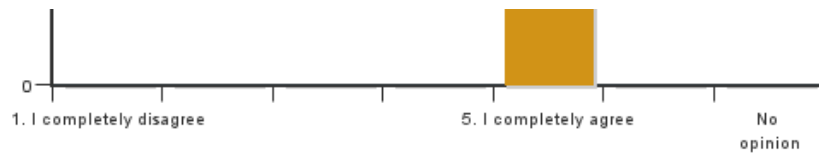

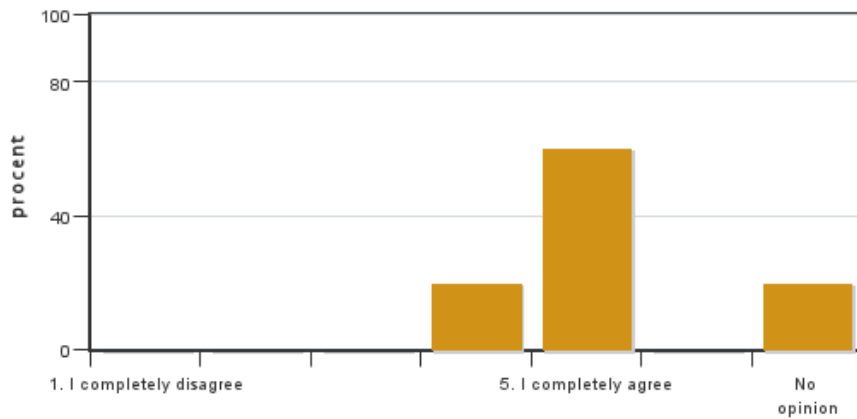

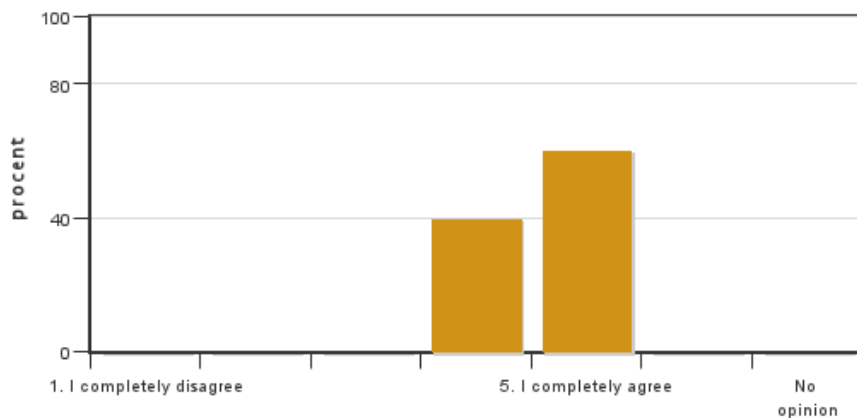

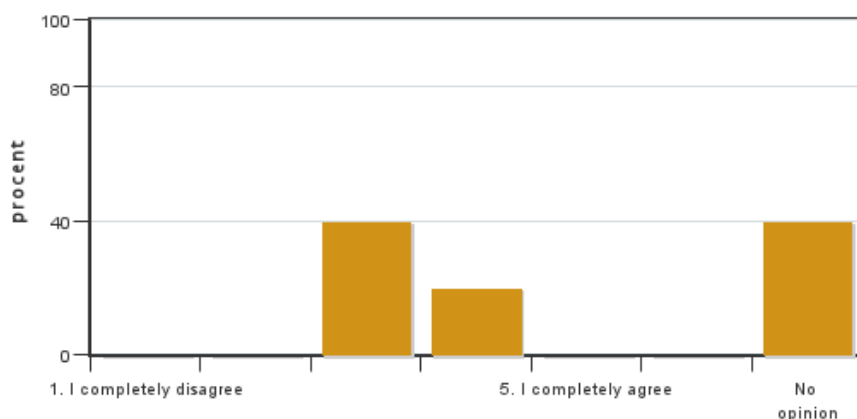

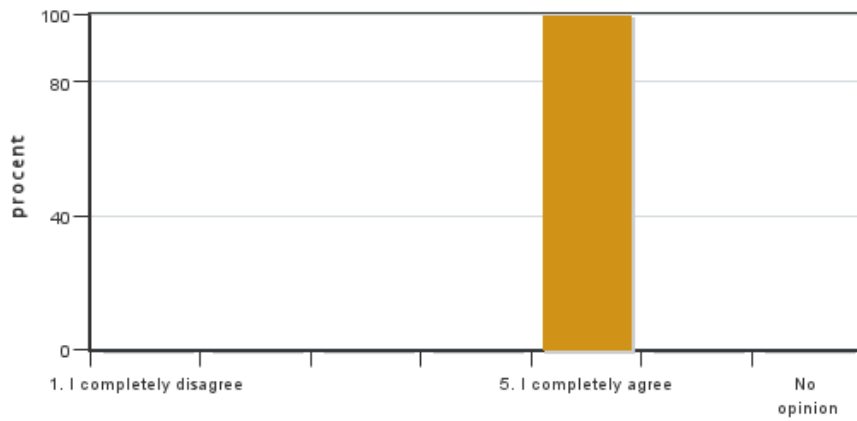

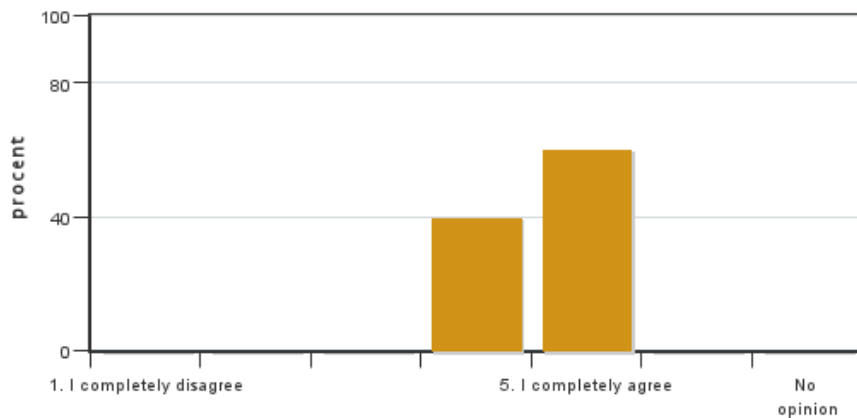

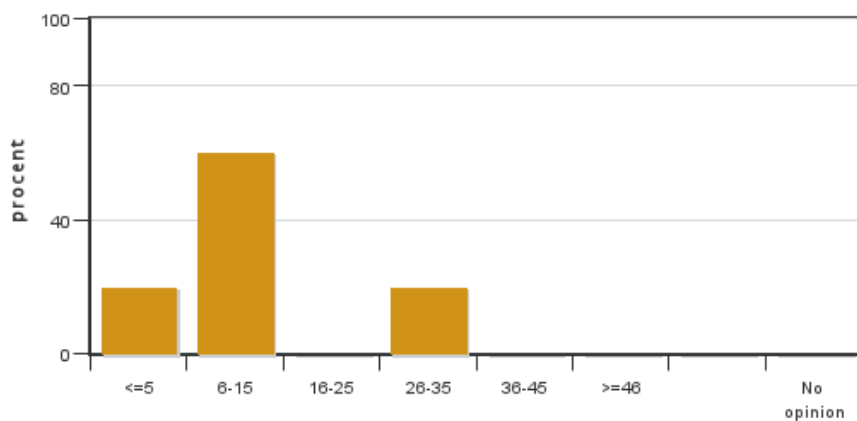

Anthrozoology in practice. Comments on course evaluation 2023. This course on advanced level is clearly an opportunity for discussion among students with various backgrounds. This year, it was biology students, veterinary nursing students, hippology students, animal welfare students. What I enjoy the most is to create the good atmosphere among these students, so we can reflect and learn together. The course is a full distance course, where there are three opportunities to meet on zoom, one in September, one in November and then the final exam in January the year after. It is a good possibility for students to work or study at the same time taking this course. The focus is on human animal interactions, from both the scientific aspects as well as from the practical aspects. Students are very happy to present their own project work during the course, and the discussions in relation to this are very fruitful for all of us. The written projects are also very impressive, and every year I encourage students to use their reports and to distribute them further. We know from experience that there are difficulties in getting students to answer a course evaluation after the course end. However, during the course I have included a number of reflections, both after every weekend, and after some of the assignments – to get the reflections from the students in relation to the different course parts.
