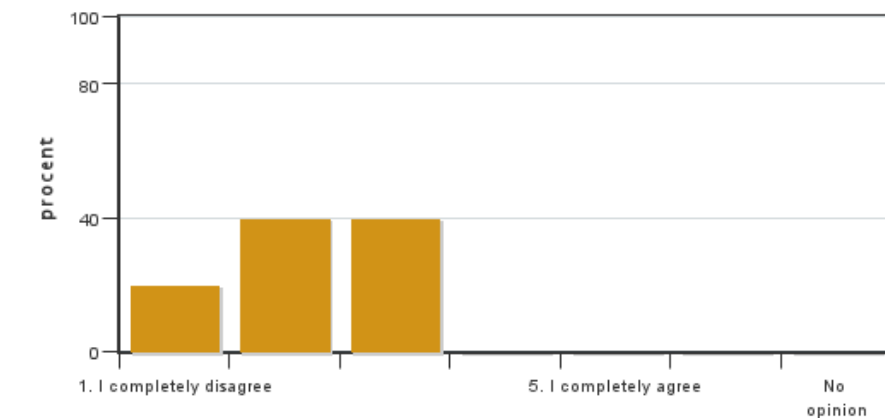

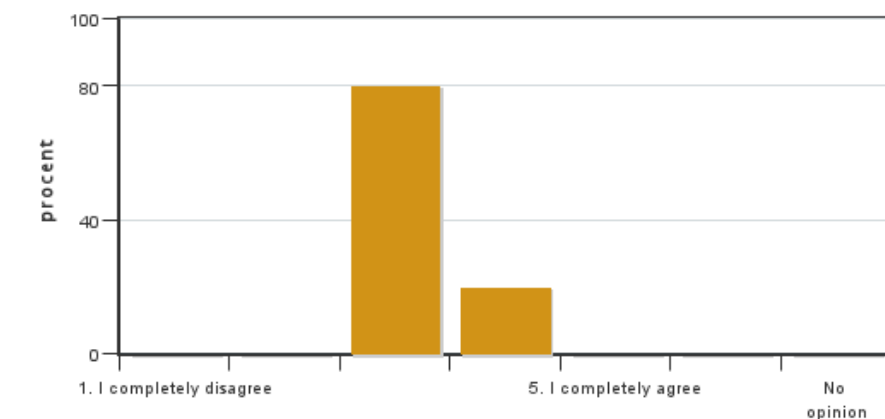

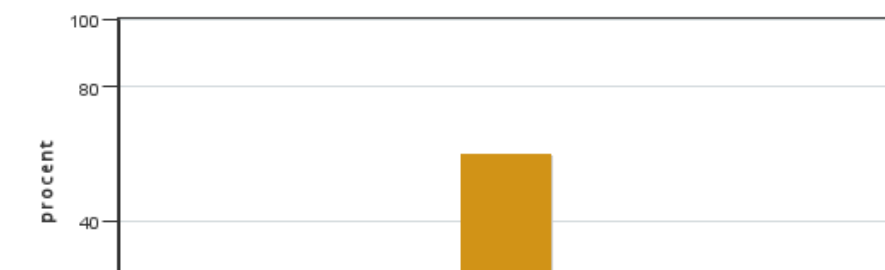

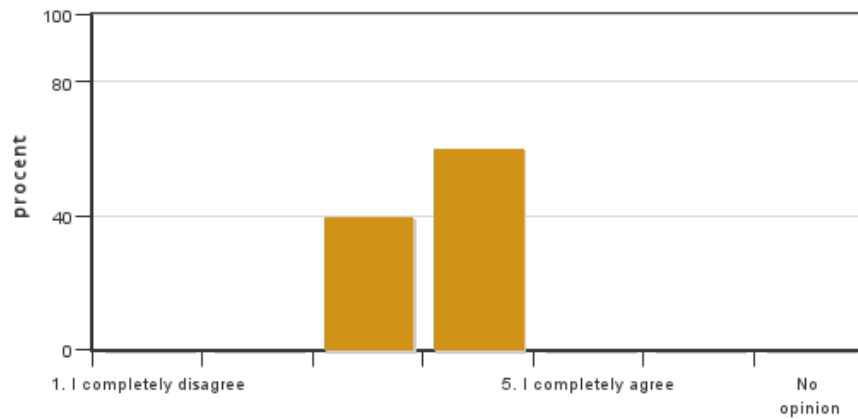

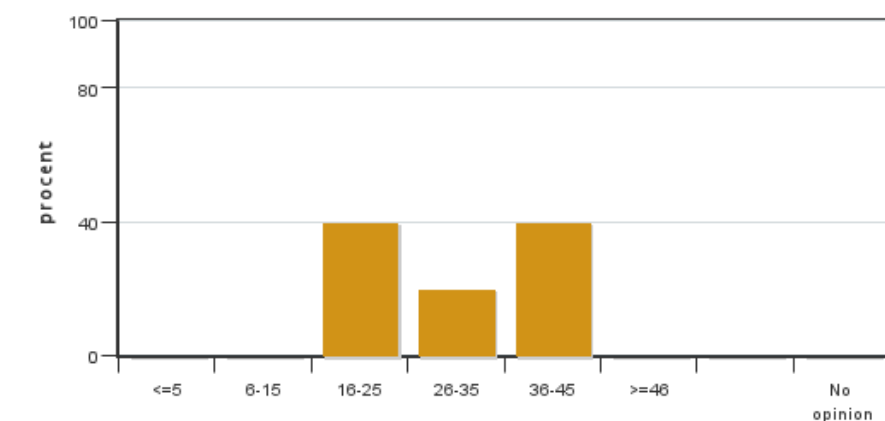

Course leaders comments

This academic year, the course evaluation yielded a low response rate (05/15), providing a somewhat limited glimpse into the students' perspectives on the course. Overall, the feedback was positive, with an average course rating of 3.0 (on a scale of 1 to 5, where 1 is very poor and 5 is very good). Students indicated a clear alignment with learning objectives, scoring an average of 3.8 (on a scale of 1 to 5, where 1 is completely disagree and 5 is completely agree).

Additionally, students found various course components to be supportive of their learning, earning a score of 3.2 (on a scale of 1 to 5, where 1 is completely disagree and 5 is completely agree). Notably, they acknowledged the course's coverage of sustainable development, giving it a score of 3.6 (on a scale of 1 to 5, where 1 is completely disagree and 5 is completely agree).

The students provided valuable suggestions to enhance examination effectiveness and foster a more inclusive social learning environment. Particularly constructive feedback was offered regarding the organization of announcements related to course lectures, seminars, and quizzes on Canvas. Students recommended addressing course-related issues in the Canvas comment section and emphasized the importance of timely dissemination of course information. The course leader and examiner will consider this feedback for improvements in the upcoming year.

General Comments:

- The overall response rate is 33%, with 5 out of 15 students providing feedback.
- Specific positive aspects include the effectiveness of examinations and the inclusive social learning environment.
- Constructive feedback highlights issues with the organization of announcements, accessibility of course materials, and limited facilities in the physical learning environment.
- Recommendations for improvement include addressing issues raised in comments, providing timely information, and enhancing accessibility.
