













Student representatives comments

The course had been fully represented by students from the master program "Food and Landscape", except of one, who wanted to join the course in order to educate him further during free gaps of his actual profession. However, unfortunately he could not go on with the study. Furthermore, all the participants came from different prior educational backgrounds and bring various individual and cultural perspectives.

The course provides huge potential to develop strategies and own ideas within a group, which is assigned to a project coming from an outside institution. However, this requires a lot of independent planning and structuring. It can be challenging to work effectively and coherent within a group. Furthermore, each individual is asked to find his position and how he could enrich the groups work. Gladly, there is the possibility to approach the advisors of the course, who provide supportive feedback and give meaningful advices.

For the next time it might be sharper distinguished between the individual work task at the start of the course and the individual reflection, that is held throughout the course. Furthermore, it was not clear which format the weekly presentation should have, whether a pitch or a presentation of the groups progress. It might be helpful have more encouragement for the students to carry out the project. For it had been questioned why someone should do this work, if one is not involved in an actual conduction of an implementation process.
