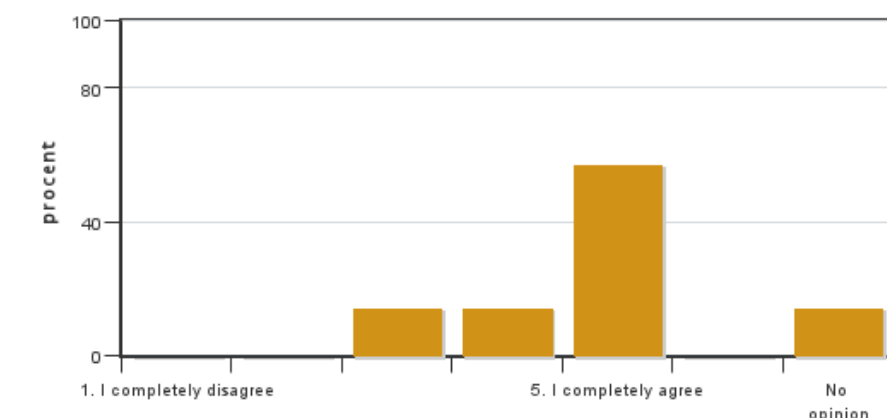

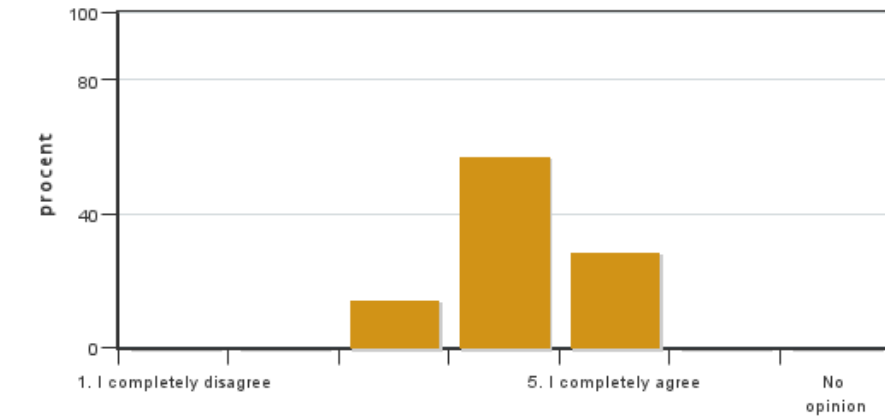

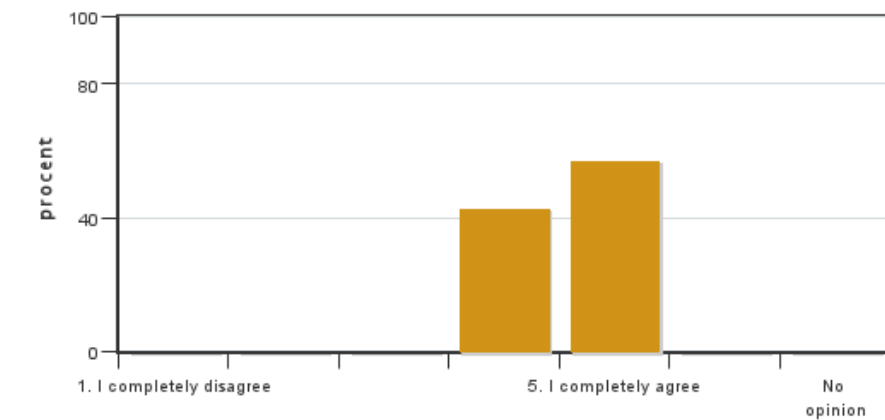

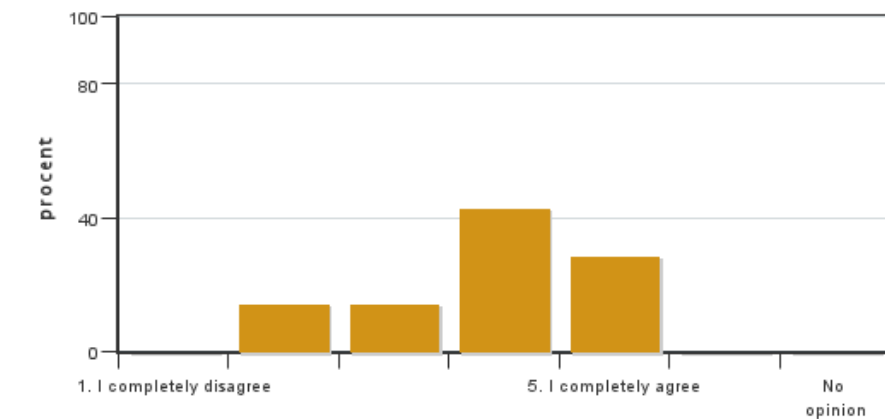

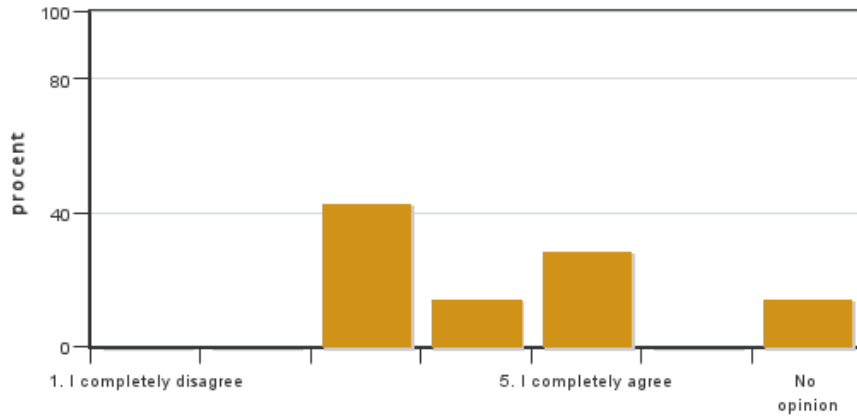

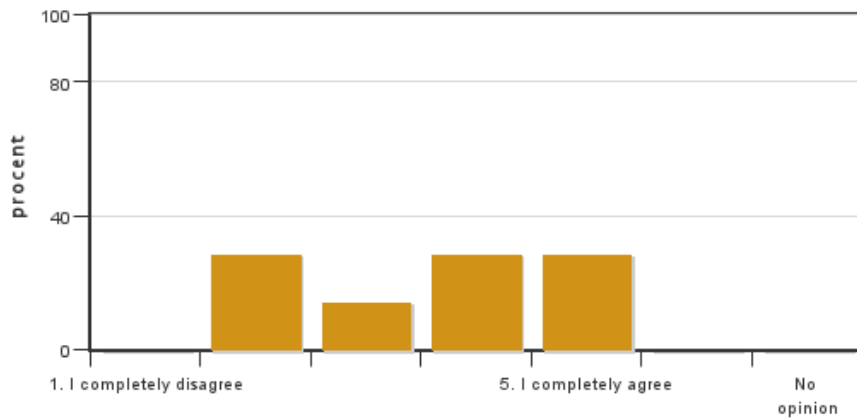

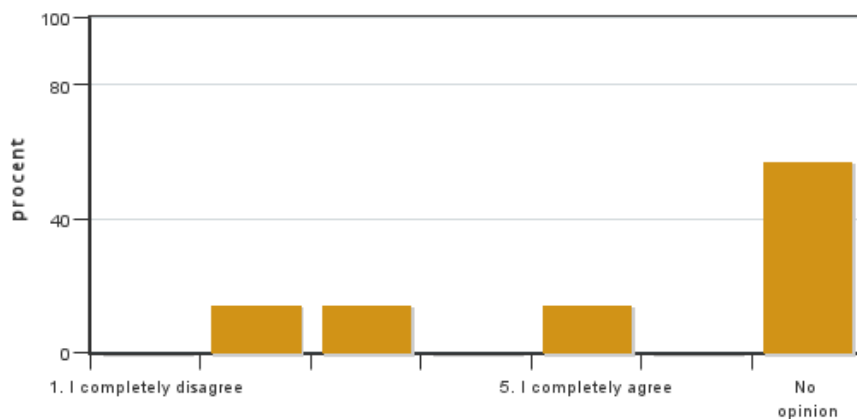

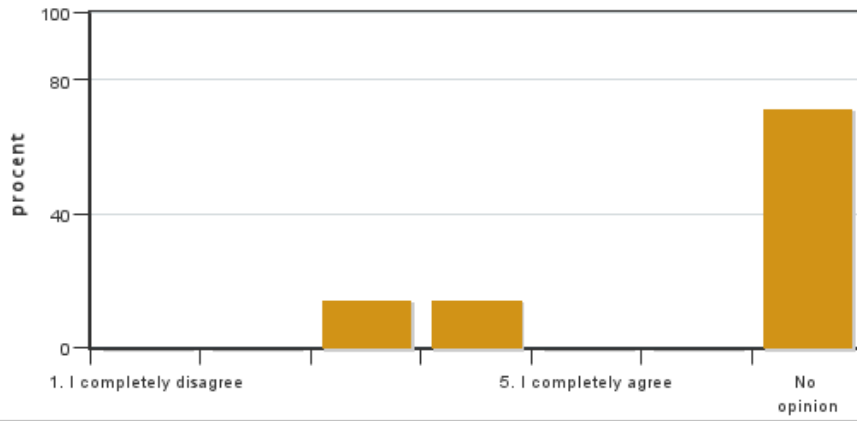

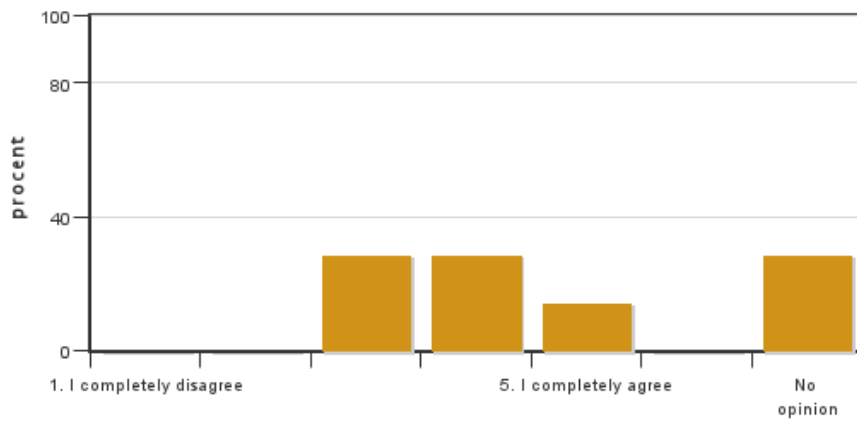

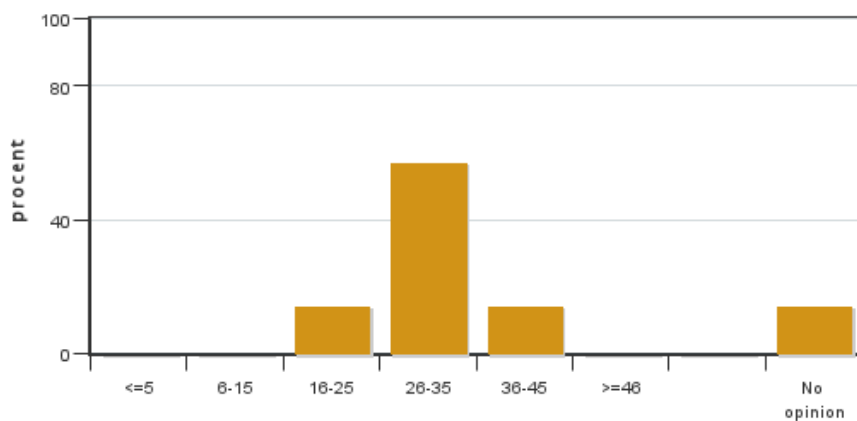

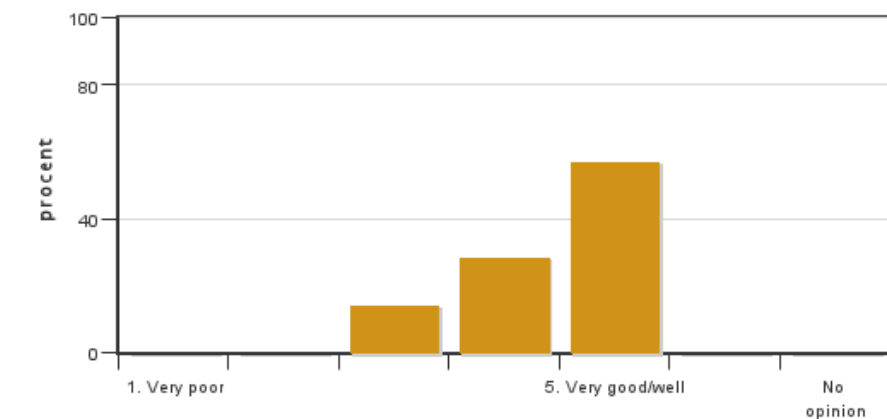

15. What do you think about the course litterature?



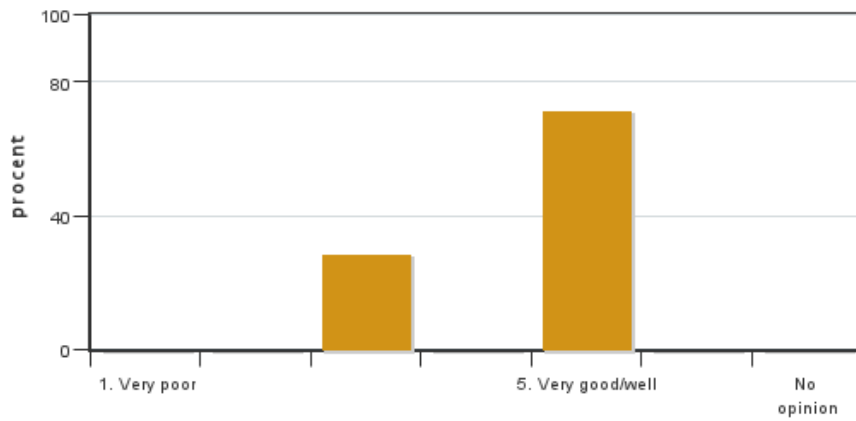

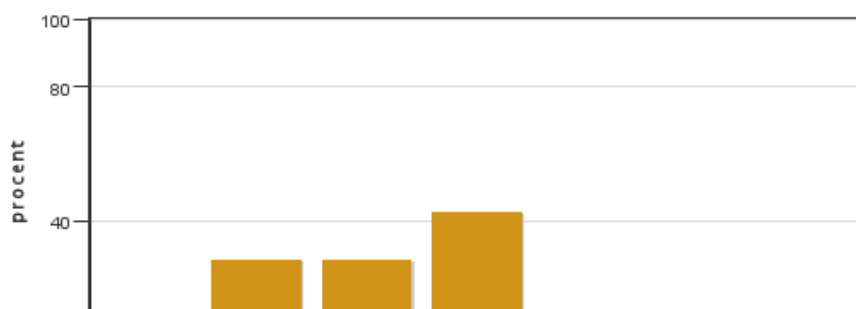
19. What do you think about the practical tasks (baking and RVA)?

Student representatives comments

Seven out of fourteen registered students, totaling 50%, participated in the course evaluation.

Overall impression:

The overall impression was fun and interesting, the students gave an overall rating of 4.1 out of 5. Most students dedicated around 26-35 hours per week to the course. Students appreciated the dedication of the course leaders, as well as the practical exercises and labs. They also valued the opportunity for open discussions and questions during both lectures and lab sessions. However, the main examination moment, the final exam, received the most criticism. Students expressed uncertainty regarding their results and felt limited in showing their full knowledge.

Learning objectives and lectures:

The feedback on the lectures varied. Lectures were informative and Roger was praised for his pedagogical way of presenting. There was critique that the lectures contained too little text which made it difficult to study and repeat the lectures at home. A greater connection to practical moments was suggested.

Course literature: Cereal book was appreciated but reading references was suggested as an improvement.

Quizzes were generally seen as a helpful learning tool and motivation for continuous studying throughout the course.

Student lectures were positively received as a fun way of learning and interacting with the course literature.

The abstract task was overall received as a good learning opportunity on critical thinking when reading science literature.

The RVA and baking lab was especially appreciated.

However, the **final examination** received the most critique for only containing four questions and not providing an opportunity for students to demonstrate what they had learned in the course.
